**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Brooklyn managed just five hits and wasted a stellar pitching performance from LHP Kevin Canelon (4-4) as they fell to State College, 2-0...Canelon struck out a career-high 11 batters, but allowed two runs on six hits over his 7.0 innings of work... Brooklyn did not get a runner to third base at any point during the game.

**VS. STATE COLLEGE:** The Cyclones are 19-10 all-time against the State College Spikes, including an 8-5 mark at MCU Park...The Spikes have won four straight from the Cyclones dating to last season.

**HOME WRECKED:** Brooklyn has lost five straight home contests, tied for the second longest home losing streak in franchise history...The Cyclones also lost five home games in a row from July 7 - July 20, 2012 and a record six straight from July 5 - July 15, 2005.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** Since July 20, Brooklyn has gone 7-18, and scored three runs or less in 17 of 23 contests.

**THE TRAGIC NUMBER:** Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 3-20...Brooklyn is 10-21 overall during this stretch.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Cyclones are 15-4 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn has lost each of their last two games when they score four or more...Brooklyn has scored two runs or less 21 times this season and are 8-13 in these games.

**GARCIA GETS GOIN:** C Jose Garcia went 2-for-3 last night and is now batting .400 (10-25) during the month of August after batting .238 (10-42) in June & July.

**SHUTOUTS:** Last night marked the fifth time this season that Brooklyn has been shutout, second most in the league behind Connecticut's six shutout losses.

**LOADED:** As a team, the Cyclones are batting .214 (9-42) with the bases loaded, including 20 strikeouts in these scoring chances.

**NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8:** Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 3-10 and been outscored 69-38...The team has surrendered 19 unearned runs in these 13 games.

**NO HIT WONDERS:** The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .221 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .233...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.202) and GCL Astros (.199)...The last NYPL team to hit below .221 was Vermont (.215) in 2003.

**NICKEL & DONE:** Last night marked the 14th time this season that Brooklyn was held to five hits or less...12 of these 14 have come since July 6th, a stretch of 35 games.

**RUNNING AT WILL:** Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 41 stolen bases over the span of 23 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .220 caught stealing percentage (18-82)...Since August 3rd, 18 of 19 would-be base stealers have been successful.

**COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION:** In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,986,105 fans to MCU Park...In the next week, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
