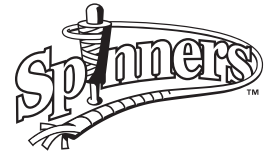

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 45-30 against the Spinners all-time...Brooklyn went 5-1 against Lowell last season, but lost 2 of 3 at Lowell earlier this season.

RECENT CYCLONES: Since July 21, Brooklyn has gone 7-19, and scored three runs or less in 20 of 26 contests... Brooklyn has lost six straight games, it is the second time this month that Brooklyn has had a losing streak of five games or more.

RUNNING ON EMPTY: Brooklyn has scored just three runs in their last 38 innings, and has one RBI in the last 44 innings with four runs scored on wild pitches, errors or double play groundouts.

HOME WRECKED: Brooklyn has lost seven straight home contests, the longest home losing streak in franchise history...The previous record was six straight losses at home from July 5 - July 15, 2005.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 3-23...Brooklyn is 10-24 overall during this stretch.

IN THE CELLAR: The Cyclones come into today's game in last place in the McNamara Division...This marks the first time in franchise history that the Cyclones have been in last place during the month of August or later...Brooklyn is one of only four professional teams to never finish below .500 since the start of the 2001 season.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 3-13 and been outscored 88-41...The team has surrendered 24 unearned runs in these 16 games and is batting just .207 (111-535) with 175 strikeouts during the month.

ALL-STARS: RHP Gaby Almonte and RHP Alex Palsha each tossed a perfect inning of relief in last night's NYPL All-Star Game in Aberdeen...2B Vinny Siena went 0-for-2 and played four innings at second base as the North affiliates defeated the South 4-2.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .216 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .231...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.206) and GCL Astros (.201)...The last NYPL team to hit below .216 was Vermont (.215) in 2003.

KEEP ON K'ING: Brooklyn leads the NYPL with 487 strikeouts this season...The Cyclones have struck out 175 times in 535 at-bats in August (32.7%).

RUNNING AT WILL: Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 48 stolen bases over the span of 26 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .220 caught stealing percentage (20-91)...Since August 3rd, 25 of 28 would-be base stealers have been successful.

FULLY LOADED: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .205 (9-44) with the bases loaded, including 22 strikeouts in these scoring chances.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,997,566 fans to MCU Park and will become the first New York-Penn League franchise to welcome 4 million fans this evening...The Cyclones are just the third short season franchise in history to reach the milestone, joining Spokane (28 seasons) and Eugene (39 seasons), and will accomplish the feat quicker than anyone else.
