ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Muckdogs scored six runs in the first inning and never looked back as they ran away with a 10-3 victory over the Cyclones on Saturday night at MCU Park...RHP **Andrew Church** (1-2) lasted just 0.2 innings, allowing six runs on six hits...3B **David Thompson** went 2-for-5 including his second home run of the season to pace the Brooklyn offense.

VS. BATAVIA: The Cyclones are 33-13 all-time against the Batavia Muckdogs and have lost the season series to the Muckdogs just once since 2007...Brooklyn is 14-6 against the Muckdogs since 2009.

WE HARDLY KNEW YE: Brooklyn RHP **Andrew Church** lasted just 0.2 inning last night, the shorting outing by a starting pitcher since LHP **Carlos Valdez** lasted just 0.2 innings on June 28, 2014 at Staten Island.

TUCK YEAH! Brooklyn OF **Tucker Tharp** has hit safely in five straight games, his longest streak of the season, and is batting .381 (8-21) over the span...The Cyclones are 8-3 this season when he scores a run.

SLUMPING SIENA: Brooklyn 2B **Vinny Siena** is 2-14 over his last four games...The former UConn Huskie has hit safely in 29 of 38 games this season and has never gone more than two games without a hit.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the New York-Penn League with a .218 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .237...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.205) and GCL Astros (.191)...Among players with with at least 74 at-bats the Cyclones have three players hitting under .200, the rest of the NYPL has just one player (Casey Hughston, WV - .191)

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 13-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn scored two runs or less in 11 of their 28 games during the month of July.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones have hit five home runs in their last four games and currently rank second in the NYPL with 21 home runs...Vermont leads the league with 23 round trippers...The Cyclones hit just 22 home runs, 13th in the league, during the 2014 season and had 25 home runs, also 13th in the league, during the 2013 campaign.

RUNNING ON E: The Cyclones rank last in the league having thrown out just 16 of 60 base stealers (.267)...The Cyclones have allowed 44 stolen bases, second most in the league (Williamsport, 46).

DIEHL WITH IT: 1B **Jeff Diehl** worked three walks in last night's game tying an individual season-high...In 83 at-bats this year, Diehl has walked a team-leading 17 times...In 118 at-bats with the Cyclones last season, he walked just four times all year.

NO E IN WIN: The Cyclones have committed at least one error in 29 of 40 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-3 when they don't commit an error, and have not been charged with an error in their last four games, a season-high.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,963,574 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
