**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 81-51 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 6-4 during the 2014 season...The 'Birds went 7-3 against BKLYN in '13, winning the season series for the first time in franchise history

**RECENT CYCLONES:** Since July 21, Brooklyn has gone 9-19, and scored three runs or less in 21 of 28 contests.

**THE TRAGIC NUMBER:** Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 4-23...Brooklyn is 11-25 overall during this stretch...Brooklyn allowed three runs last night, but won the game 4-3...It was their first win in which they allowed more than one run since August 3rd.

**NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8:** Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 5-13 and been outscored 92-48...The team has surrendered 24 unearned runs in these 17 games and is batting just .207 (124-599) with 197 strikeouts during the month.

**NO HIT WONDERS:** The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .216 team average while Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .230...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.208) and GCL Astros (.201)...The last NYPL team to hit below .216 was Vermont (.208) in 2001.

**KEEP ON K'ING:** Brooklyn batters lead the NYPL with 509 strikeouts this season...There are six teams in the NYPL with at least 100 fewer strikeouts than Brooklyn.

**FULLY LOADED:** As a team, the Cyclones are batting .205 (9-46) with the bases loaded, including 22 strikeouts in these scoring chances.

**BROOKLYN FOR THREE:** The Cyclones will be going for their third straight win this evening...Brooklyn has not won three consecutive games during the month of August and have just one three-game streak since July 12th.

**PEDRO PEREZ:** INF/OF Pedro Perez went 2-for-3 last night, snapping a 0-for-19 skid dating to July 28th...For Perez, it was just his third multi-hit game of the season and his first since July 10th.

**POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones are tied for sixth in the NYPL with 23 home runs but have not had a round tripper since August 11th when 1B Zach Mathieu hit a three-run shot against Staten Island...Coming into tonight's game, Brooklyn has gone 242 at-bats without a home run.

**BRANDON BROSHER:** C Brandon Brosher went 2-for-5 last night for his first multi-hit game since July 31st...The Brooklyn backstop has 21 strikeouts in 39 games during August including 10 in his last 13 at-bats.

**RUNNING AT WILL:** Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 49 stolen bases over the span of 27 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .223 caught stealing percentage (21-94)...Since August 3rd, 26 of 29 would-be base stealers have been successful.

**ROAD SWEET ROAD:** 3B David Thompson is batting .303 (27-89) in 26 road games and .146 (12-82) in 24 games at MCU Park...1B Jeff Diehl is batting .300 (18-60) on the road and .232 (16-69) at home.

**NICKEL & DIME:** The Cyclones are hitting .155 (25-161) over their last five games and .211 (74-350) over their last 10 games.
