VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 83-53 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 3-4 during the 2015 season...The 'Birds went 7-3 against BKLYN in '13, winning the season series for the first time in franchise history.

RECORD LOW: With 12 games remaining, Brooklyn has 455 total hits...The previous franchise low is 562 hits during the 2006 season...That team hit .231, also a low.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 6-27...Brooklyn is 14-29 overall during this stretch.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 8-17 and been outscored 121-69...The team has surrendered 26 unearned runs in these 25 games and is batting just .211 (177-839) with 268 strikeouts during the month.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .216 team average while Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .235...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.207) and GCL Astros (.200).

KEEP ON K'ING: Brooklyn batters lead the NYPL with 577 strikeouts this season...The Cyclones have 100 or more strikeouts than 10 teams in the NYPL

ONE L IN BROOKLYN?: Since the franchise began in 2001, the Brooklyn Cyclones have never finished below .500...They are one of only four professional teams to not have a losing season in this span (NY Yankees, AZL Giants, Elizabethton Twins)...Brooklyn finished 38-38 during the 2002 season, the team's worst record.

BACK-TO-BACK SHUTOUT: Through the first 14 seasons of Cyclones baseball, the team was shutout in back-to-back games on three occasions ('02, '13 & '14)...In the last two weeks it has happened twice to the Cyclones...Brooklyn has been shutout in three straight games only once in franchise history, from August 27-29, 2002 in a three-game series against the Staten Island Yankees.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night was the eighth time this season that Brooklyn has been shut out, the most in the NYPL, and tied for the franchise record for shutouts in a season with the 2013 Cyclones...The Cyclones have not scored a run in 19.0 innings coming into tonight's game...Their season-long drought was 22.0 innings from August 13th-15th.

HOME WRECKED: The Cyclones are 2-10 at MCU Park during the month of August and have been outscored 59-27 in these contests...The Cyclones are batting .185 (74-401) at home during this span.

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones have 23 home runs this season but have not had a round tripper since August 11th when 1B Zach Mathieu hit a three-run shot against Staten Island...Coming into tonight's game, Brooklyn has gone 482 at-bats without a home run.

ZACH ATTACK: 1B Zach Mathieu has hit safely in a season-high six straight games (.375, 9-24)...The six game hitting streak is also tied for his career-high, done on two occasions with the Kingsport Mets in August of the 2014 season...During his pro career, Mathieu is batting .158 in June and July (33-209), and .271 (51-188) in August.
