**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 83-54 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 3-5 during the 2015 season...The 'Birds went 7-3 against BKLYN in '13, winning the season series for the first time in franchise history.

**NICKEL & DIME:** Over thier last five games, Brooklyn is batting .180 (29-261) with seven runs scored...In their last 10 contests, the Cyclones are batting .210 (70-334).

**THE TRAGIC NUMBER:** Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 6-28...Brooklyn is 14-30 overall during this stretch.

**NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8:** Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 8-18 and been outscored 126-71...The team is batting just .208 (181-869) with 279 strikeouts during the month.

**NO HIT WONDERS:** The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .215 team average while Lowell ranks 13th in the league at .235...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.207) and GCL Astros (.201).

**KEEP ON K'ING:** Brooklyn batters lead the NYPL with 591 strikeouts this season...There are 10 teams in the NYPL that have at least 100 fewer strikeouts...Last night was their 10th time in 13 games with at least 10 K's.

**ONE L IN BROOKLYN?:** Since the franchise began in 2001, the Brooklyn Cyclones have never finished below .500...They are one of only four professional teams to not have a losing season in this span (NY Yankees, AZL Giants, Elizabethton Twins)...Brooklyn finished 38-38 during the 2002 season, the team's worst record.

**DEUCES WILD:** Last night was the 16th time in 26 games during August that Brooklyn has scored two runs or less...Brooklyn is 1-15 in these games...For the season the Cyclones have two runs or less in 31 games and are 8-23 overall.

**RECORD LOW:** With 12 games remaining, Brooklyn has 459 total hits...The franchise low is 562 hits during the 2006 season...That team hit .231, also a franchise low...The last New York-Penn League team to hit below .215 was the Vermont Expos in 2001 (.208).

**HOME WRECKED:** The Cyclones are 2-11 at MCU Park during the month of August and have been outscored 64-29 in these contests...The Cyclones are batting .181 (78-431) at home during this span.

**ROAD SWEET ROAD?:** As a team, Brooklyn is hitting .202 (213-1052) at MCU Park and have scored just 102 runs in 33 games at home (3.09 runs per game)...On the road Brooklyn is batting .227 (246-1083) and have 118 runs in 32 games. (3.69 runs per game).

**POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones have 23 home runs this season but have not had a round tripper since August 11th when 1B Zach Mathieu hit a three-run shot against Staten Island...Coming into tonight's game, Brooklyn has gone 512 at-bats without a home run.

**GARCIA GETS GOING:** C Jose Garcia is batting .364 (16-44) in 16 games during the month of August.

**FIVE & DONE:** Last night marked the 20th time this season that Brooklyn was held to five hits or less, including each of their last three games.
