ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones sent just one batter over the minimum to the plate as they lost to the Batavia Muckdogs 1-0 on Sunday afternoon at MCU Park...Chris Flexon (0-2) allowed one unearned run in 4.2 innings, walking five and striking out four...The lone run of the game scored on a passed ball...Brooklyn did not get a runner to second base until the bottom of the 8th inning.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 44-28 against the Spinners all-time...Brooklyn went 5-1 against Lowell last season, including 3-0 at LeLachur Park.

NOTES FROM YESTERDAY: The Cyclones had just 26 official at-bats yesterday's game, a franchise-low for a nine inning game...Brooklyn managed just two hits and two walks, but grounded into two double plays and had one base runner picked off.

TRIPPING ON THE ROAD: Brooklyn is just 2-6 in their last eight road games, and have scored just 24 runs in these eight games...The Cyclones are batting .173 (46-266) in these eight games.

SLUMPING SIENA: Brooklyn 2B Viny Siena is 2-15 (.133) over his last five games...The former UConn Huskie has never gone more than two games without a hit during his pro career.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the New York-Penn League with a .216 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .238...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.205) and GCL Astros (.191)...Among players with with at least 76 at-bats the Cyclones have three players hitting under .200, the rest of the NYPL has just one player (Casey Hughston, WV - .191)

TEAM BATTING: The Cyclones are currently batting .216 as a team, the franchise mark for lowest batting average as a team is .230, set during the 2012 season...Since the Cyclones joined the NYPL in 2001, no team has finished the year hitting lower than .221 (Connecticut, 2013).

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 13-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season...Brooklyn has scored two runs or less 16 times this season and are 7-9 in these games.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones have hit five home runs in their last five games and currently rank second in the NYPL with 21 home runs...Vermont leads the league with 24 round trippers...The Cyclones hit just 22 home runs, 13th in the league, during the 2014 season and had 25 home runs, also 13th in the league, during the 2013 campaign.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: As a team, the Cyclones are hitting .222 (143-645) on the road and .210 (143-681) at home...3B David Thompson is batting .311 (19-61) on the road and .158 (0-57) at home.

NO E IN WIN: The Cyclones have committed at least one error in 29 of 41 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-4 when they don't commit an error, and have not been charged with an error in their last five games, a season-high.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,969,896 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
