ABOUT LAST NIGHT: It was another night to forget for the Brooklyn Cyclones as they were hammered by the Lowell Spinners 12-0 on Wednesday evening... RHP **Gaby Almonte** (5-3) allowed a franchise-record 10 runs, nine earned, in 3.0 innings...The Cyclones also committed four errors and had two position players, **Pedro Perez** and **Zach Mathieu**, toss scoreless innings of relief.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 53-23 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters, including 15-3 over the last three seasons, including 7-2 at MCU Park...Brooklyn won the season series 5-1 in 2012, 2013 & 2014...The Cyclones went 2-1 in the matchup at MCU Park earlier this season.

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the Cyclones and Lake Monsters last played on July 20th, Brooklyn has gone 5-10, and scored three runs or less in 12 of 15 contests.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 3-14...Brooklyn is 8-15 overall during this stretch.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 14-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season...Brooklyn has scored two runs or less 18 times this season and are 7-11 in these games...Brooklyn has scored one run or less on nine occasions, including last night.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .220 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .237...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.203) and GCL Astros (.196)...Among players with at least 81 at-bats, the Cyclones have three players hitting under .200, with no other players matching this criteria.

NICKEL & DONE: Last night marked the 12th time this season that Brooklyn was held to five hits or less...Ten of these 12 have come since July 6th, a stretch of 28 games.

PINCH PITCHING?: Brooklyn INF **Pedro Perez** and 1B **Zach Mathieu** both made their professional pitching debuts in last night's blowout loss...They became the fifth and sixth position players to take the mound for the Cyclones and the first since SS **Ismael Tijerina** took the mound twice in 2013...Tijerina spent the 2014 season as a relief pitcher for the K-Mets, going 1-0 with a 2.21 ERA.

SLUMPING SIENA: Brooklyn 2B **Vinny Siena** is 5-27 (.185) over his last eight games...The former UConn Huskie, who struck out just 13 times in his first 86 at-bats, has now struck out 17 times in his last 73 at-bats including, six games with multiple strikeouts.

RISP, NO REWARD: Brooklyn went 2-for-20 with runners in scoring position in their last two games and are hitting .251 (85-329) with RISP this season...Since July 1st the team is batting .217 (55-253) with RISP after batting .341 (29-85) in June...With RISP and two-outs, the team is batting .184 (21-114) over this same period after batting .419 (18-43) in June.

RUNNING AT WILL: Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 30 stolen bases over the span of 15 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .243 caught stealing percentage (17-70).

10 RUNS: Last night Brooklyn starter Gaby Almonte allowed 10 runs, nine earned, on eight hits in 3.0 innings of work...The runs allowed is the most by any Cyclones pitcher in franchise history. The previous mark was 9 runs set by RHP **Casey Mesiner** on July 5, 2014 vs. ABD.
