ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones extended their winning streak to five after topping the Renegades in a rain-shortened seven inning affair in Brooklyn...LHP **Blake Taylor** and RHP **Andrew Church** both made successful Cyclone debuts with Church (1-0) getting the win following 3.0 strong innings of relief...LHP **Carlos Valdez** earned his second save of the season after tossing a scoreless seventh and final inning...The Cyclones have now won six straight at MCU Park dating back to June 26th.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 77-54 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split the 2014 season series 5-5...The Cyclones are 27-17 against the Renegades since 2011.

GETTING GOING VS. 'GADES: The Cyclones are 4-1 against Hudson Valley this season and have allowed just five earned runs in these five games...Brooklyn has outscored Hudson Valley 16-8 in these contests.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.19 ERA (9 ER / 68.1 IP) this season...Five of those nine runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...Coming into tonight, Brooklyn relievers have allowed two runs over their last 42.1 innings...The bullpen has allowed just one run in 22.1 innings during the month of July.

SUMMER IN THE CITY: The Cyclones are 7-1 during the month of July and have allowed just seven earned runs (11 runs total) in these eight games...The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 29-11...The opposition is batting just .155 and has 37 hits in 70.0 innings so far...Brooklyn pitchers have compiled 69 strikeouts.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night was Brooklyn's league-leading fourth shutout of the season, two of which have come against the Renegades...It was the 105th shutout in Cyclones history...Brooklyn led the NYPL with 10 shutouts during the 2014 season and have collected double digit shutout wins in six of their 14 seasons.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Lost in Brooklyn's current five game winning streak is their offensive struggles...The Cyclones are batting .200 (29-145) with 19 runs scored over the span...Brooklyn pitchers have allowed just four earned runs in 44.0 innings (0.82 ERA) of work over the five game winning streak.

AT HOME ON THE ROAD: Brooklyn comes into tonight's contest with a 6-2 record on the road this season...OF **Michael Bernal** is batting .429 (12-28) on the road and .208 (5-24) at MCU Park...Similarly, 3B **David Thompson** is batting .417 (10-24) on the road and .227 (5-22) at home.

MONTY BURNS: RHP **Christian Montgomery** has been on fire to start the season with the Cyclones...The righthander has 12 strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work this season and has allowed just three hits...Prior to this season, the 11th round pick in the 2011 draft had never had back-to-back outings in which he had not allowed a run and was unscored upon in only four of his 17 appearances.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,896,058 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.
