ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones defeated the Iron-Birds by the score of 2-1 on Saturday evening...LHP **Kevin Canelon** (2-1) got the win after tossing 6.1 innings, allowing just two hits, including a solo home run, while striking out four...Offensively, 1B **Pedro Perez** had a two-RBI single in the bottom of the second that would prove to be all the offense the Cyclones would need...RHP **Alex Palsha** tossed a 1-2-3- ninth for his league leading 5th save.

VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 81-49 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 6-4 during the 2014 season...The 'Birds went 7-3 against BKLYN in '13, winning the season series for the first time in franchise history

SAME OLD SIENA: 2B **Vinny Siena** has hit safely in 18 of 20 games this season, and has reached base safely in 19 of 20 games, including 13 straight contests dating to June 26th....Since the start of his junior season at UConn, the Mets 14th round selection has reached base safely in 76 of 80 games.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.05 ERA (9 ER / 77.1 IP) this season...Five of those nine runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...Coming into tonight, Brooklyn relievers have allowed three runs over their last 51.1 innings...The bullpen has allowed just one earned run in 31.1 innings during the month of July.

SUMMER IN THE CITY: The Cyclones are 8-2 during the month of July and have allowed just 13 earned runs (18 runs total) in these 10 games...The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 36-18 during the month despite hitting .230 (73-317) as a team.

HIGH WATER MARK: With a win this evening, the Cyclones would climb to 10 games over .500 for the first time since September 5, 2012 when Brooklyn completed the regular season with a record of 45-31.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones have won seven straight home games, the longest home winning streak since winning 10 consecutive home games from July 8-July 23, 2010...The longest home winning streak in franchise history is 19 games, set during the 2001 season.

SLOW BERN: OF **Michael Bernal** is 0-for13 with five strikeouts over his last three games...The slugger is batting .222 (6-27) during the month of July after batting .314 (11-35) in June.

WON RUN: Brooklyn collected their league leading seventh one-run win of the season last night, and the team is now 7-3 in one run games this season...Brooklyn also improved to 11-2 when they score the first run of the game.

MONTY BURNS: RHP **Christian Montgomery** has been on fire to start the season with the Cyclones...The righthander has 16 strikeouts in 8.1 innings of work this season and has allowed just three hits...Prior to this season, the 11th round pick in the 2011 draft had never had back-to-back outings in which he had not allowed a run and was unscored upon in only four of his 17 appearances.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,903,073 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.
