ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The slumping Cyclones lost in a rather unique way on Wednesday night as LHP Carlos Valdez (1-1) was called for a balk, in the middle of an intentional walk, to allow the winning run to score in the bottom of the 10th as Brooklyn fell 3-2 to Staten Island... Brooklyn managed just four hits in the loss.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold a 97-889 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series... Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2014 and have lost the season series just once since 2007. (2013)

SLUMPING CYCLONES: Brooklyn enters tonight 1-4 over their last five games after beginning the season 14-5...The team is batting just .200 (33-165) over this span with just 12 runs scored.

SAME OLD SIENA: 2B Vinny Siena has hit safely in 20 of 23 games this season, and has reached base safely in 22 of 23 games, including 16 straight contests dating to June 26th....Since the start of his junior season at UConn, the Mets 14th round selection has reached base safely in 79 of 83 games.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.22 ERA (12 ER / 88.1 IP) this season...Five of those ten runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...The bullpen has allowed just four earned run in 42.1 innings during the month of July. (0.85 ERA)

E FOR EFFORT: Brooklyn has lost four-of-five games and have committed 11 errors during this span, including tying a franchise record with five errors on Sunday, July 12th...The Cyclones are tied for 9th in the NYPL with a .964 fielding percentage and have been charged with 345 errors on the year.

WORST & FIRST: The Cyclones currently rank last in the New York-Penn League in batting average, hitting just .221 as a team, Lowell ranks 13th in the league with a .237 average...Conversely, Brooklyn leads the NYPL with a 2.44 ERA, allowing just 59 earned runs in 217.2 innings.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Currently, there are eight of 15 position players on the Cyclones roster batting .200 or less...Among qualifying batters, three of the 10 lowest batting averages in the NYPL are held by Cyclones.

SLOW BERN: OF Michael Bernal is 1-for-25 with eight strikeouts over his last six games...The slugger is batting .179 (7-39) during the month of July.

NOT SO HOT: After beginning the season with a 10-game hitting streak, 1B Jeff Diehl is just 1-for-15 over his last six games with an at-bat...3B David Thompson is 1-for-20 dating to July ninth, with his lone hit coming last night against the Yankees.

BASHING VS. BROOKLYN: Yankees OF Jhalan Jackson is hitting .389 (7-18) with two home runs and seven RBI in four games against the Cyclones this season... Against the rest of the NYPL he is hitting .257 (9-35) with two home runs and seven RBI in 11 games.

NEW ADDITIONS: OF Hengelbert Rojas and RHP Chris Flexen have joined the Cyclones roster...Rojas appeared in 11 games with the K-Mets, while Flexen continues to rehab from Tommy John Surgery.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,915,279 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
