ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones ended their four-game home losing streak in a big way on Sunday evening, scoring seven runs on ten hits as they ran away with a 7-1 victory over the Vermont Lake Monsters...RHP Gaby Almonte (3-2) got the win after tossing 6.1 strong innings, allowing just one run on five hits...OF Hengelbert Rojas went 2-for-3 with 3 RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 52-23 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters, including 15-3 over the last three seasons, including 7-2 at MCU Park...Brooklyn won the season series 5-1 in 2012, 2013 & 2014.

NOTES ON LAST NIGHT: The seven runs scored last night was tied for their highest output during the month of July, and marked the first time they scored more than five runs since July 5th...The 10 hits collected by the Brooklyn bats was the first time they reached double digit hits since July 10th at Hudson Valley in a 12 inning game.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.06 ERA (12 ER / 102.0 IP) this season...Five of those 12 runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...The bullpen has allowed just four earned runs in 57.0 innings during the month of July. (0.63 ERA)

E FOR EFFORT: Brooklyn has lost six-of-nine games and committed 16 errors during this span, including tying a franchise record with five errors on Sunday, July 12th...The Cyclones are tied for 10th in the NYPL with a .964 fielding percentage and have been charged with 40 errors on the year.

COMEBACK TRAIL: INF Will Fulmer (ankle), out since June 29th, and C Jose Garcia (thumb) have both been cleared to return to action.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 10-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in eight of their 17 games during the month of July.

VINNY VAN GO: Cyclones 2B Vinny Siena was 1-for-15 going into his final at-bat on Saturday night...Since then, the second baseman is 4-for-5...The 14th round pick from UConn has never had back-to-back games without a hit this season.

HEATING UP: OF Michael Bernal went 3-for-5 with his first RBI during the month of July in yesterday's win...He is batting .429 (6-14) over his last three games after a 1-for-33 stretch from July 9th - July 16th.

ROCKIN' ROJAS: OF Hengelbert Rojas went 2-for-3 yesterday with three RBI...It was his highest RBI output since a four-RBI game on August 15, 2012 with the DSL Mets vs. DSL Pirates...The 21-year-old has hit safely in all three games since joining Brooklyn on July 17th.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Currently, eight of 16 position players on the Cyclones roster are batting .200 or less...Among qualifying batters, two of the four worst batting averages in all of the New York-Penn League are on the Cyclones.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,936,915 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
