ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones struggles continued on Wednesday night as they fell to the Black Bears by the score of 8-1...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with five errors, and manages just six hits...RHP **Matt Blackham** (2-2) recorded just four outs and allowed six runs, four earned, on seven hits and was saddled with the loss...DH **Jeff Diehl** provided the lone run of the game with a solo-blast in the second, his third of the year.

VS. WEST VIRGINIA: Last night marked the first meeting between the West Virginia Black Bears and the Cyclones...The Black Bears moved from Jamestown prior to the start of the 2015 season...The Cyclones were 22-20 against the Jammers....The Black Bears are the first new franchise in the NYPL since the Oneonta Tigers moved to Connecticut in 2010.

RUNNING ON EMPTY: The Black Bears have stolen nine bases in the last two games against the Cyclones...Brooklyn ranks last in the New York-Penn League, throwing out just 11 of 44 would-be base stealers...The 33 stolen bases ranks 11th in the league.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.52 ERA (20 ER / 118.2 IP) this season...They have surrendered 10 of those 20 runs in two games, an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City and five runs on July 21st at West Virginia.

E FOR EFFORT: Brooklyn has lost eight of 12 games and committed 24 errors during this span, including tying a franchise record with five errors twice during this stretch: July 12th vs. ABD & July 22nd at WV ...The Cyclones are tied for 11th in the NYPL with a .962 fielding percentage and have been charged with 47 errors on the year.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 11-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season...Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in nine of their 20 games during the month of July.

HEATING UP: OF **Michael Bernal** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 18 plate appearances...He is batting .421 (8-19) over his last five games after a 1-for-33 stretch from July 9th - July 16th.

ALL OR NOTHING: C **Brandon Brosher** has nine hits in 17 games this season...Six of these nine hits have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 3 home runs).

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Currently, seven of 16 position players on the Cyclones roster are batting .200 or less...Among qualifying batters, two of the three worst batting averages in all of the New York-Penn League are on the Cyclones.

INJURY BUG: RHP **Matt Blackham** reported right hip tightness after finishing his first inning of work last night...He complained of the injury after falling awkwardly on the third out in the first inning...He is day-to-day...LHP **Blake Taylor** received treatment on his left elbow soreness yesterday and will refrain from throwing until asymptomatic.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,943,614 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
