ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones skid continued as they fell at Hudson Valley, 4-3 in 10 innings...Brooklyn rallied late to tie the game in the 8th, only to lose in the bottom of the 10th when home plate umpire Greg Roemer called C Brandon Brosher for obstruction, allowing the winning run to score instead of sending the game to the 11th inning.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 4-3 against Hudson Valley this season and are 77-56 against the Renegades all-time.

E FOR EFFORT: Brooklyn has lost 12 of 17 games and committed 31 errors during this span, including tying a franchise record with five errors twice during this stretch: July 12th vs. ABD & July 22nd at WV ...The Cyclones are 10th in the NYPL with a .962 fielding percentage and have been charged with 54 errors on the year...Only two teams have committed for errors: Vermont (58) and Batavia (69).

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 11-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season...Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in 11 of their 25 games during the month of July and have not scored more than three runs in a game since July 20th.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Currently, seven of 16 position players on the Cyclones roster are batting less than .200...Among qualifying batters, two of the three worst batting averages in all of the New York-Penn League are on the Cyclones....SS Alfredo Reyes is batting .149 (14-94), which is worst in the New York-Penn League among qualifying batters, and ranks fourth worst in all of Minor League Baseball among qualifying individuals.

A SEASON OF FIRSTS: Last night's obstruction call to end the game marked the first time in New York-Penn League history that a game has ended due to an obstruction call...On the road trip July 23rd at West Virginia, 3B David Thompson was struck out on a dead ball strike for stepping out of the batter's box, that had also never happened in NYPL history.

RISP, NO REWARD: The Cyclones went 1-6 on their road trip and are hit just .130 (7-54) with runners in scoring position during this stretch....During the month of July Brooklyn is batting .225 (43-191) with RISP and .188 (16-85) with RISP / 2 outs...The Cyclones hit .341 (29-85) with RISP in June and .419 (18-43) with RISP / 2 outs.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the New York-Penn League with a .218 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .235... The .218 average ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams with only the GCL Rays (.198) and GCL Astros (.196) hitting worse...Brooklyn has just 20 hits in their last four games...Brooklyn also ranks 13th in the league with 133 runs scored in 36 games (3.69 per game).

NO E IN WIN: The Cyclones have committed at least one error in 29 of 36 games this season...Brooklyn is 5-2 when they don't commit and error and have never gone more than two games (July 4 - 5) without an error.

COUNTOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,943,614 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
