ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones defeated the Hudson Valley Renegades by the score of 6-3 at MCU Park on Wednesday evening...OF **Tucker Tharp** went 2-for-4, including his first professional home run, and 1B **Jeff Diehl** also added a two-run blast to pace the Brooklyn bats...LHP **Kevin Canelon** (3-2) tossed 6.0 strong innings, striking out a season-high seven batters and allowing just one run on four hits.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 5-3 against Hudson Valley this season and are 78-56 against the Renegades all-time.

E FOR EFFORT: Brooklyn has lost 12 of 18 games and committed 31 errors during this span, including tying a franchise record with five errors twice during this stretch: July 12th vs. ABD & July 22nd at WV...The Cyclones are 9th in the NYPL with a .963 fielding percentage and have been charged with 54 errors on the year.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 12-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in 11 of their 26 games during the month of July and have not scored more than three runs in a game since July 20th.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Currently, seven of 16 position players on the Cyclones roster are batting less than .200...Among qualifying batters, two of the three worst batting averages in all of the New York-Penn League are on the Cyclones...SS **Alfredo Reyes** is batting .153 (15-98), which is worst in the New York-Penn League among qualifying batters, and ranks fourth worst in all of Minor League Baseball among qualifying individuals.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** is batting .455 (10-22) against lefthanded pitching this season...2B **Vinny Siena** is batting .333 (9-27)...As a team Brooklyn is batting .228 against southpaws with only one home run in 250 at-bats.

TUCK YEAH: Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** connected on a 2-2 offering from RHP Roel Ramirez in the fifth inning last night for his first professional home run...Tharp had gone 329 professional at-bats without a home run.

RISP, NO REWARD: The Cyclones are hitting just .138 (8-58) with runners in scoring position over their last eight games...During the month of July, Brooklyn is batting .226 (44-195) with RISP...The Cyclones hit .341 (29-85) with RISP in June

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the New York-Penn League with a .220 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .234... The .220 average ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams with only the GCL Rays (.198) and GCL Astros (.196) hitting worse...Brooklyn also ranks 13th in the league with 139 runs scored in 37 games (3.76 per game).

NO E IN WIN: The Cyclones have committed at least one error in 29 of 37 games this season...Brooklyn is 6-2 when they don't commit an error and have never gone more than two games (July 4-5) without an error.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,950,996 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in history.
