ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Hudson Valley Renegades avoided a three-game sweep, defeating the Cyclones 4-1 at Dutchess Stadium...RHP **Nicco Blank** (0-1) was tagged with the loss after making an emergency start when RHP **Mike Gibbons** was promoted to Binghamton (AA)...2B **Vinny Siena** had the lone RBI of the game.

VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 40-27 against the Williamsport Crosscutters...The Cyclones swept a three-game series from the 'Cutters in 2014.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,875,091 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.

KIND OF A BIG DIEHL: 1B/OF **Jeff Diehl** went 1-for-4 yesterday and is batting .407 (13-35) on the season...He has hit safely in each of his 10 starts this season...Diehl hit safely in his last game of the 2014 season with the Cyclones (August 13) so he currently has an 11 game hitting streak...The Rhode Island native also had an 11 game hitting streak with the Cyclones last season, and is one of just four players in franchise history to have multiple double-digit hitting streaks, joining OF **Angel Pagan**, OF **Joe Holden** and 3B **Jhoan Urena**...Diehl's streak is the 34th double digit hitting streak in franchise history.

SEE YA LATER: 1B **Michael Katz** and C **Nata Ramos** were both promoted to Savannah (A) of the South Atlantic League following Wednesday night's game...RHP **Mike Gibbons** was promoted to Binghamton (AA) yesterday and will join Savannah (A) later on today.

VINCENT CAN GO: 2B **Vinny Siena** has hit safely in 12 of his 13 games as a professional, including each of his last six starts...Dating back to the start of his Junior season with UConn, the 14th round selection has reached base safely in 66 of his last 73 contests...The Cyclones infielder ranks third in the NYPL with a .388 (19-49) average and is fourth with a .455 on-base percentage.

IN A PINCH: Wednesday, INF **Pedro Perez** hit a pinch hit home run in the ninth vs. Hudson Valley...It was the first pinch hit home run by a Cyclone since August 23, 2009 when Scott Grimes hit a pinch hit home run vs. Oneonta.

ALL-STARS: The Eastern League has announced their mid-season All-Stars, and three former Cyclones will represent Binghamton in the game on July 15th...OF **Brandon Nimmo**, RHP **Paul Sewald** and RHP **Luis Cessa** were all named to the team...In addition OF **Travis Taijeron** was named to the Pacific Coast League All-Star Team, representing Las Vegas (AAA).

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.62 ERA (9 ER / 50.0 IP) this season...Five of those nine runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...Coming into tonight, Brooklyn relievers have allowed two runs over their last 27.2 innings of work, and have scattered just 12 hits over this span.

INJURY BUG: Last night OF **Michael Bernal** left the game with a right groin injury...He is considered day-to-day...INF **Will Fulmer** injured his left ankle on June 30th and is also day-to-day...RHP **Ty Williams** has not pitched this season due to a right shoulder injury and there is no timetable for his return.
