**OPENING DAY:** The Cyclones are 11-3 all-time on Opening Day and 7-1 since 2007, with their lone loss coming at the hands of the Staten Island Yankees in 2013...This season marks the 12th time that the Cyclones and Yankees will square off on Opening Day with the Cyclones holding a 9-2 advantage in these games...The Cyclones and Staten Island have opened the season against each other every year since 2005.

**AT HOME ON ROAD:** Tonight will mark the eighth time that Brooklyn opens the season on the road...The Cyclones are 5-2 in these games, including 3-1 at Staten Island.

**VS. STATEN ISLAND:** The Cyclones hold an 95-87 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series... Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2014 and have lost the season series to the Baby Bombers just once since 2007. (2013)

**NEW LOOK:** The Cyclones have a brand-new road uniform for the 2015 season...Brooklyn is the first professional baseball team to debut Rawlings new "faux-flanel" pattern...The jersey features "BKLYN" across the chest... The team also unveiled two new caps which will be worn on the road, one featuring the traditional BC in a light blue and an alternate design that features an outline of the Brooklyn Bridge.

**SINCE WE LAST MET:** Since the Cyclones played their last game, MCU Park has hosted over 100 collegiate, high school and little league games, drew over 30,000 fans for two nights of Grammy-Award winning Mumford & Sons shows, hosted the New York Empire ultimate frisbee, and the FXFL's Brooklyn Bolts.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** The Cyclones roster features three players that were recently selected in the 2015 MLB Draft RHP **Corey Taylor** (7th Round Texas Tech), LHP **P.J. Conlon** (13th Round - San Diego), 2B **Vinny Siena** (14th Round - UConn).

**DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:** There are nine players on the current roster that played for the Cyclones in 2014: RHP **Gaither Bumgarnder**, LHP **Carlos Valdez**, INF **Jeff Diehl**, INF **Will Fulmer**, INF **Michael Katz**, INF **Pedro Perez**, INF **Alfredo Reyes**, OF **Tucker Tharp**, and OF **Michael Bernal**.

**DOUBLED UP:** OF Tucker Tharp and OF Michael Bernal were both in the Opening Day lineup in 2014...They are just the 14th and 15th players in franchise history to make two starts on Opening Day.

**BIG CROWDS:** The Staten Island Yankees are expecting one of the largest crowds in ballpark history this evening...The largest crowd in MCU Park history was 10,073 on September 7, 2007 and the team has drawn over 8,000 fans on 214 times in franchise history.

**PLAYER COACH:** Cyclones hitting coach **Yunir Garcia** is the second person to both play and coach for the Cyclones, joining former hitting coach Bobby Malek... Garcia played in 37 games with Brooklyn in 2003 and 12 games in 2004...Overall, he played in 292 minor league games in the Mets system, making it as high as Norfolk (AAA) in 2006.

**TOMORROW:** The family of police officer Wenjian Liu, who lived and worked in Brooklyn before being killed in the line of duty earlier this year, will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at MCU Park.

- Made four starts for the GCL Mets in 2014...Went 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA, allowing just three runs, earned, in 19.0 innings...Limited the opposition to a .182 batting average as a starter.
- In five road appearances in 2014, posted a 0.95 ERA (2 ER / 19.0 IP).
- Attended Dowling College in Oakdale, Long Island...During his senior season with the Golden Lions, went 9-3 with a 0.83 ERA in 15 games, 13 starts...Tossed five complete games and struck out 129 batters in 108.1 IP.
