ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones rallied from an early 2-0 deficit to win 3-2 in 12 innings last night at Richmond County Bank Ballpark...OF **Michael Bernal** had an RBI single that scored OF **Enmanuel Zabala** in extra to give Brooklyn the win.

HOME OPENER: The Cyclones are 12-2 all-time in Home Openers, including 9-2 against the Staten Island Yankees...One of their two home losses was the worst loss in franchise history, as Brooklyn fell to Staten Island 18-0 to open the home schedule in 2006.

OPENING DAY SUCCESS: The Cyclones improved to 12-3 on Opening Day thanks to their win last night... Brooklyn is 10-2 on Opening Day against the Staten Island Yankees.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold an 96-87 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series... Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2014 and have lost the season series to the Baby Bombers just once since 2007. (2013)

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the Cyclones played their last game, MCU Park has hosted over 100 collegiate, high school and little league games, drew over 30,000 fans for two nights of Grammy-Award winning Mumford & Sons shows, hosted the New York Empire ultimate frisbee, and the FXFL's Brooklyn Bolts.

FLORIDA STATE LEAGUE ALL-STARS: The best from around the FSL will square off at St. Lucie tonight for the 2015 FSL All-Star Game...Former Cyclones **Akeel Morris** and **Michael Conforto** were named to the game, but both have been promoted to Binghamton (AA).

PRE-GAME: The family of NYPD officer Wenjian Liu, who lived and worked in Brooklyn before being killed in the line of duty earlier this year, will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at MCU Park.

BIG CROWDS: Last night the Cyclones played in front of an RCB Ballpark record 7,483...The largest crowd in MCU Park history was 10,073 on September 7, 2007 and the team has drawn over 7,500 fans on 300 occasions in franchise history.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: The Cyclones roster features three players that were recently selected in the 2015 MLB Draft RHP **Corey Taylor** (7th Round Texas Tech), LHP **P.J. Conlon** (13th Round - San Diego), 2B **Vinny Siena** (14th Round - UConn).

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK: There are nine players on the current roster that played for the Cyclones in 2014: RHP **Gaither Bumgarnder**, LHP **Carlos Valdez**, INF **Jeff Diehl**, INF **Will Fulmer**, INF **Michael Katz**, INF **Pedro Perez**, INF **Alfredo Reyes**, OF **Tucker Tharp**, and OF **Michael Bernal**.

DOUBLED UP: OF **Tucker Tharp** and OF **Michael Bernal** were both in the Opening Day lineup in 2014... They became just the 14th and 15th players in franchise history to be in the lineup in multiple Opening Days.

PLAYER COACH: Cyclones hitting coach **Yunir Garcia** is the second person to both play and coach for the Cyclones, joining former hitting coach **Bobby Malek**... Garcia played in 37 games with Brooklyn in 2003 and 12 games in 2004...Overall, he played in 292 minor league games in the Mets system, making it as high as Norfolk (AAA) in 2006.
