ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones led wire-to-wire en route to a 6-4 victory over the Staten Island Yankees in the rubber game of a three-game series...RHP Michael Gibbons (1-0) got the win after allowing just two runs on two hits over 5.2 innings...DH Jeff Diehl paced the Brooklyn bats with two hits, including a solo home run in the eighth inning that tacked on a much needed insurance run.

VS. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 36-27, but are 1-4 in playoff games against the ValleyCats...Brooklyn went 2-4 against Tri-City in 2014, and 3-3 against them in 2013...The Cyclones haven't won the season series since 2010.

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the Cyclones played their last game, MCU Park has hosted over 100 collegiate, high school and little league games, drew over 30,000 fans for two nights of Grammy-Award winning Mumford & Sons shows, hosted the New York Empire ultimate frisbee, and the FXFL's Brooklyn Bolts.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,837,736 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.

RISP/ REWARD: Through the first three games of the season, Brooklyn is batting .471 (8-17) with runners in scoring position and two out...Brooklyn has scored 12 runs this season and eight of them have crossed the plate with two outs.

OPENING SERIES: Brooklyn took two of three from the Staten Island Yankees in the Opening Series of the season...The Cyclones have won the Opening Series of the season each of the last two seasons, and eight times in the last nine years...They lost each game of a rain-shortened series to Staten Island in 2013.

HE DID WHAT?: RHP **Corey Taylor** is expected to make his professional debut this evening after being selected in the 7th Round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech...Taylor led all of the NCAA this season with a 0.31 ERA...He allowed two earned runs in 57.1 IP over 19 games with the Red Raiders.

PLAYER COACH: Cyclones hitting coach **Yunir Garcia** is the second person to both play and coach for the Cyclones, joining former hitting coach **Bobby Malek**... Garcia played in 37 games with Brooklyn in 2003 and 12 games in 2004...Overall, he played in 292 minor league games in the Mets system, making it as high as Norfolk (AAA) in 2006.

CYCLONES IN SAVANNAH: The Savannah (A) Sand Gnats of the South Atlantic League clinched the first half title and ensured a spot in the playoffs come September...Former Cyclone RHP **Casey Meisner** was named to the SAL All-Star Game after going 7-2 with a 2.13 in 12 starts...The game will be played tomorrow night at McCormick Field in Asheville, North Carolina.

SCHOOL IS IN SESSION: Wednesday night the Cyclones will hose the VALLEY-cats for Saved by the Bell Night at MCU Park...The promotion garnered national attention in February when it was announced, including a spot on ESPN's SportsCenter...Dennis Haskins, who played the role of Mr. Belding will be in attendance.
