**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The ValleyCats snapped a 22.0 inning scoreless streak with three runs in the top of the 1st and never looked back as they ran away with an 11-4 victory at MCU Park on Tuesday...LHP **Kevin Canelon** (0-1) allowed six runs, five earned, in 2.1 innings of work and was tagged with the loss...OF **Michael Bernal** was the lone bright spot for the Brooklyn offense as he hit his second two-run home run in as many nights.

**VS. TRI-CITY:** The Cyclones lead the all-time series 37-28, but are 1-4 in playoff games against the ValleyCats...Brooklyn went 2-4 against Tri-City in 2014, and 3-3 against them in 2013...The Cyclones haven't won the season series since 2010.

**HIT ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** The Tri-City Valley Cats collected 16 hits last night...For Brooklyn it was the most hits they have allowed in a game since July 5, 2014 when they surrendered 18 hits to the Aberdeen IronBirds in a 18-2 loss at MCU Park...The franchise record for hits allowed is 21, on August 21, 2006 vs. Staten Island.

**COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION:** In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,848,375 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.

**RISP/ REWARD:** Through the first four games of the season, Brooklyn is batting .462 (12-26) with runners in scoring position and two outs...For the season, Brooklyn has 12 RBI with two-outs, and 14 RBI with less than two outs.

**BERNING UP:** Through the first five games of the season, OF **Michael Bernal** is batting .368 (7-19)...He leads the team with two home runs and eight RBI...The 23-year-old has at least one RBI in four of five games this season...Equally impressive is that he has two games without a strikeout in his first five starts after having only nine such games in 71 contests last season...In 2014 with the Cyclones, Bernal hit just .224 (13-58) in 17 games during the month of June.

**TO ERR' IS HUMAN:** Through the first five games of the 2015 season, the Cyclones have been charged with eight errors, and have at least one miscue in every game...As a team, the Cyclones have a .962 fielding percentage which ranks ninth in the NYPL.

**NICE TO MEET "U":** 3B **David Thompson**, selected in the 4th Round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of the University of Miami, officially signed with the Mets on Monday and has joined the Cyclones...He will be activated this afternoon in time for tonight's game...Thompson was one of just three players to receive unanimous All-American first-team honors...He led the nation with 19 home runs and 90 RBI in 67 games for the Hurricanes.

**SCHOOL IS IN SESSION:** This evening is Saved by the Bell Night at MCU Park as the team honors one of the most popular shows on-air in the early 90s...The promotion garnered national attention in February when it was announced, including a spot on ESPN's SportsCenter...Dennis Haskins, who played the role of Mr. Belding, will be in attendance...The team will be wearing special SBTB themed jerseys that will be raffled off during the game and auctioned off through CyclonesAuthentics.com following the game.
