ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones topped the VALLEYcats by the score of 2-1 in 12 innings on Saved by the Bell Night at MCU Park...1B **Jeff Diehl** ripped a triple to rightfield with one out in the bottom of the 12th to chase DH **Michael Katz** all the way around from first with the game-winning run...LHP **Carlos Valdez** (1-0) tossed 2.0 scoreless innings to collect his first win of the season...The Cyclones bullpen combined on 7.1 scoreless frames, allowing just four hits and striking out eight.

VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones and Tigers have split their all-time series 15-15...Brooklyn went 2-4 against the Tigers last season, including 2-1 at MCU Park...The Cyclones do not have a losing record against any team in the New York-Penn League.

ON THIS DATE: On June 25, 2001 the Brooklyn Cyclones brought professional baseball back to Brooklyn in what is still considered to be the most memorable game in franchise history...With Brooklyn trailing 2-0 in the bottom of the ninth with two outs, 3B Edgar Rodriguez hit a game-tying home run, before a C Mike Jacobs sac fly in the 10th won the game for Brooklyn.

COUNTDOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,856,251 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.

RISP/ REWARD: Through the first four games of the season, Brooklyn is batting .433 (13-30) with runners in scoring position and two outs...For the season, Brooklyn has 13 RBI with two-outs, and 15 RBI with less than two outs.

BERNING UP: Through his first five games of the season, OF **Michael Bernal** is batting .368 (7-19)... He leads the team with two home runs and eight RBI... The 23-year-old has at least one RBI in four of five games this season...Equally impressive is that he has two games without a strikeout in his first five starts after having only nine such games in 71 contests last season...In 2014 with the Cyclones, Bernal hit just .224 (13-58) in 17 games during the month of June.

TO ERR' IS HUMAN: Through the first six games of the 2015 season, the Cyclones have been charged with 12 errors, and have at least one miscue in every game...As a team, the Cyclones have a .954 fielding percentage which ranks 10th in the NYPL.

NICE TO MEET "U": 3B **David Thompson**, selected in the 4th Round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of the University of Miami, officially signed with the Mets on Monday and has joined the Cyclones... He is expected to activated by the end of the week... Thompson was one of just three players to receive unanimous All-American first-team honors...He led the nation with 19 home runs and 90 RBI in 67 games for the Hurricanes.

THE FUTURE STARTS IN BKLYN: Earlier today, former Cyclones OF **Michael Conforto** and OF **Brandon Nimmo** were named to the US team for the 2015 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game to be played at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati on July 12th...Conforto, a 2014 Cyclone, is hitting .308 (80-265) with 20 doubles, nine home runs, and 31 RBI in 68 combined games between St. Lucie (A) and Binghamton (AA)...Nimmo, who played in Brooklyn in 2012, was named to the game for the second time...Is batting .300 (54-180) with the B-Mets.
