ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones used a five-run fifth inning to propel them to a 11-4 win over the Auburn Doubledays on Monday night at Falcon Park...OF Michael Bernal came up just a single short of the cycle, going 3-for-4 with three runs scored, two RBI and a home run to pace the Brooklyn offense...RHP Matt Blackham struck out nine over 4.2 innings, but also walked four, and did not factor in the decision...RHP Gaither Bumgardner tossed 1.1 scoreless frames in relief to get the win.

VS. AUBURN: The Cyclones are 27-19 all-time against the Auburn Doubledays...Brooklyn went 2-1 against the Doubledays in 2014, and are 10-4 against Auburn since 2011

COUNTOWN TO 4 MILLION: In the 15th season of Cyclones baseball, the team has drawn 3,869,812 fans to MCU Park...Later this summer, the team will welcome their 4,000,000th fan through the gates, a mark they will reach quicker than any short-season team in the history of Minor League Baseball.

RISP/ REWARD: Through the first nine games of the season, Brooklyn is batting .419 (18-43) with runners in scoring position and two outs...For the season, Brooklyn has 18 RBI with two-outs.

BERNING MAN: Cyclones OF Michael Bernal is off to a scorching hot start for Brooklyn...The rightifelder is tied for second in the NYPL with three home runs, ranks second with an .844 slugging percentage, ranks second with eight extre-base hits, leads the league with 11 runs scored, and is second with 27 total bases...The 23 year-old slugger has hit safely in seven of his nine games this season and has reached base safely in each of his starts this season.

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has pitched to a 1.62 ERA (7 ER / 39.0 IP) this season...Five of those seven runs allowed came in an 11-4 loss on June 23rd vs. Tri-City...Coming into tonight, Brooklyn relievers haven't allowed a run over their last 16.2 innings of work, and have scattered just five hits over this span.

TO ERR' IS HUMAN: Through the first 10 games of the 2015 season, the Cyclones have been charged with 16 errors, and have at least one miscue in every game...As a team, the Cyclones have a .960 fielding percentage which ranks 9th in the NYPL.

VINNY CAN GO: 2B Vinny Siena went 2-for-5 last night, and has now hit safely in nine of his 10 games as a professional...Dating back to the start of his Junior season with UConn, the 14th round selection has reached base safely in 63 of his last 70 contests...The Cyclones infielder is batting .600 (6-10) with runners in scoring position.

NEW KID IN TOWN: C Brandon Brosher has joined the Cyclones after beginning the season with the GCL Mets as he rehabbed from a hand injury sustained in extended Spring Training...Brosher hit .077 (1-13) in five games with the GCL Mets before joining the Cyclones on Sunday...Brosher missed most of the 2014 season after breaking his right fibula...Hit four home runs in seven games with the K-Mets before his injury.

KIND OF A BIG DIEHL: 1B/OF Jeff Diehl went 1-for-2 yesterday and is batting .435 (20-23) on the season... He has hit safely in each of his seven starts this season and has at least one extra base hit in six of these seven games...Diehl hit safely in his last game of the 2014 season (August 13) so he currently has a eight game streak.
