VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones and Connecticut are tied 16-16 in the all-time series...Brooklyn went 2-4 against the Tigers last season, including 0-3 at Dodd Stadium.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 7-31...Brooklyn is 15-33 overall during this stretch.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: August, 2015 was the worst month in Cyclones franchise history...Brooklyn went 9-20 and was outscored 145-87 during the month... The Cyclones went 12-15 in July '12, their previous low for a full calendar month.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .220 team average while Lowell ranks 13th in the league at .235...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.208) and GCL Astros (.200).

KEEP ON K'ING: Brooklyn batters lead the NYPL with 632 strikeouts this season...Brooklyn has double digit strikeouts in 12 of their last 17 games.

ONE L IN BROOKLYN?: Since the franchise began in 2001, the Brooklyn Cyclones have never finished below .500...They are one of only four professional teams to not have a losing season in this span (NY Yankees, AZL Giants, Elizabethton Twins)...With one more loss this season, the Cyclones will ensure their first losing season in franchise history.

ZACH ATTACK: 1B Zach Mathieu is batting .341 (15-44) over his last 11 and has 16 RBI in his last 17 contests.

DOUBLEHEADERS: The Cyclones will be playing their first doubleheader of the season today...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley, who also has a twinbill today, are the last NYPL teams to play a doubleheader this season...Brooklyn is 41-35 all-time in doubleheaders.

REYES IS RAKING: Since August 19th, SS Alfredo Reyes has hit safely in 13 of 14 games and is batting .317 (19-60) to raise his average from .196 to .231... Reyes hit .311 (32-103) in August, after having just 15 hits in June and July combined.

RECORD LOWS: With 7 games remaining, Brooklyn has 499 total hits...The franchise low is 562 hits during the 2006 season...That team hit .231, also a franchise low... The last New York-Penn League team to hit below .220 was the Vermont Expos in 2001 (.208)...The Cyclones have score 240 runs this season, the franchise record for fewest runs scored is 251 during the 2006 season.

FULLY LOADED: The Cyclones are batting .203 (10-49) with the bases loaded this season...The team has 23 strikeouts in these 49 at-bats with the bags full.

PITCHING IN: Cyclones pitchers allowed 145 runs, 117 earned, in 29 games during the month of August...Brooklyn pitchers allowed 127 runs, 103 earned, in 39 games during the months of June and July combined.

MORE H THAN K: Currently, there are three players on the Cyclones roster that have more hits than strikeouts: C Jose Garcia (27 H, 22 K), 2B Vinny Siena (68 H, 53 K), and 3B David Thompson (44 H, 43 K).
