VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 100-93 against the Baby Bombers all-time...Brooklyn's victory on August 10th, marked the first time that Brooklyn collected 100 wins against any franchise...The Yankees lead the 2015 series 6-5, including going 5-0 at MCU Park.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 8-35...Brooklyn is 17-37 overall during this stretch.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .221 team average while Lowell ranks 13th in the league at .237...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.208) and GCL Astros (.200). The last New York-Penn League team to hit below .221 was the Vermont Expos in 2001 (.208)

ONE L IN BROOKLYN: Brooklyn's loss Wednesday night was their 39th of the season, ensuring them their first losing season in franchise history...The AZL Giants, Elizabethton Twins and New York Yankees are now the only affiliated franchises to not have a losing season dating back to the start of the 2001 season...Elizabethton Twwon their last three games of the season to finish 34-34, the AZL Giants went 31-25.

INJURY BUG: INF **Branden Kaupe** injured his left wrist on Thursday and his season is over...INF **Will Fulmer** is suffering from right elbow soreness...INF **David Thompson** has left wrist soreness and is not expected to play.

Z'S HEATING UP: OF **Enmanuel Zabala** has 4 straight multi-hit games (.529, 9-17)...Had 4 in 56 games

PLAYOFF SCENERIOS: The Staten Island Yankees can clinch a McNamara Division title with a win this evening or an Aberdeen loss...With a Yankees loss and an Aberdeen win, the IronBirds would win the McNamara Division title...West Virginia will win the wild card with a victory this evening...Aberdeen would win the wild card with a win and West Virginia loss...State College would clinch the wild card with an Aberdeen loss and West Virginia loss.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: The Cyclones as a team are batting .240 (150-626) against lefthanded pitching compared to .214 (392-1831) against righties...Manuel Hilario is batting .269 (7-25) against lefties and .100 (5-50) against righties...OF Enmanuel Zabala is hitting .295 (13-44) against southpaws and .209 (27-129) against RHP.

HOME WRECKERS: Brooklyn is 3-12 at MCU Park since August 1st...The Cyclones have been outscored 73-42 in these contests...Brooklyn is 16-20 at home overall, the worst record in franchise history.

REYES IS RAKING: Since August 19th, SS **Alfredo Reyes** has hit safely in 17 of 20 games and is batting .300 (24-80) to raise his average from .196 to .232...Reyes hit .311 (32-103) in August, after having just 15 hits in June and July combined.

RECORD LOWS: With 1 game remaining, Brooklyn has 542 total hits...The franchise low is 562 hits during the 2006 season...That team hit .231, also a franchise low.

THE E IN CYCLONES: Brooklyn has been charged with 97 errors this season, including 17 in their seven games during the month of September.
