LAST GAME: The Cyclones saw their six game winning streak come to a close, falling to the Vermont Lake Monsters 7-1 on Saturday night in Burlington...Vermont scored four unearned runs over the first two innings and never looked back...RHP **Justin Dunn** (1-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing four runs, zero earned, on five hits over 3.0 IP...Brooklyn's lone run scored on a wild pitch.

10 K CLUB: LHP **Thomas Szapucki** struck out 10 over his 7.0 innings of work yesterday...It was the fourth time this season that a Cyclones pitcher has reached double digit strikeouts, with RHP **Harol Gonzalez** reaching the mark three times in 2016, and the 43rd time in franchise history...Szapucki is just the fifth lefthanded pitcher to strike out double digits joining **Mike Cox** (2001), **Evan MacLane** (2004), **Dario Alvarez** (2013), and **Kevin Canelon** (2x - 2015).

NEED FOR SPEED: OF **Jacob Zanon** currently leads the New York-Penn League in stolen bases with 17...The last Cyclone to steal more than 17 bases in a season was OF **Darrell Ceciliani** who swiped 21 during the 2010 season...The franchise record for steals was set by OF **Angel Pagan** who stole 30 bags in 2001.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn is 11-13 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 10-9 in one-run games and 1-4 in two-run games...The 19 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL.

IN A DAYS: Brooklyn is 15-3 in Sunday - Tuesday games and is 6-18 from Wednesday - Saturday.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the IronBirds 89-56...Brooklyn is 46-25 at Ripken Stadium and 43-31 at MCU Park... Since 2013, the series is tied 15-15...Brooklyn won or split the season series with the IronBirds every year from 2002-2012, with Aberdeen taking the 2013 series 7-3...Brooklyn is 5-2 against Aberdeen this season.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones Manager **Tom Gamboa** comes into tonight's game with 96 wins as manager of the Cyclones...He would become just the third manager in franchise history to eclipse the 100 win mark, joining **Edgar Alfonzo** (146 wins) and **Rich Donnelly** (128 wins).

SHUTOUTS: Last night marked the fourth time this season that the Cyclones have been shut out, and the fourth time the team has been shut out at home.. Brooklyn ranked second in the league in 2015 when they were shut out eight times, seven of which were at MCU Park.

GOOD WOOD: SS **Colby Woodmansee** comes into tonight's game with a nine-game hitting streak and is batting .364 (12-33) over this stretch...With a hit tonight, he would become the 35th player in franchise history with a 10+ game hitting streak and the first since 1B **Jeff Diehl** hit in 11 straight last year. ...**Woodmansee** also leads all NYPL shortstops with a .986 fielding percentage...The former Arizona State Sun Devil has been charged with just two errors in 139 chances and has just one error since July 2nd.

BEATING THE BIRDS: Brooklyn is 5-2 against Aberdeen this season and Cyclones pitchers have struck out 82 batters in 65.0 innings.

LAST START: Comes into tonight's game having won each of his last three starts...Has allowed just a single run in all three outings...Took the mound in the first game of a doubleheader on July 26th vs. Staten Island and got the win as Brooklyn rallied for a 2-1 victory.

CLUNKER: Allowed nine runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings at Batavia on July 6th...Aside from that start, Manóah is 4-0 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP).

HOME COOKIN: In 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA in four starts at home this season...Opponents are batting just .210 (17-81) at MCU Park.

SWEET SIX-CESS: Has never thrown more than 6.0 innings in a start during his career...Was reached the 6.0 inning mark three times this season, and seven times in his career.

LONG BALL: Has allowed three home runs over 36.1 innings this season, the three home runs allowed tie him for fourth in the NYPL...Has allowed 10 home runs, including a league-leading seven with Kingsport in 2015, over his 125.1 career innings.

CAREER NIGHT: Struck out a career-high nine batters on July 1st at CT.

RISP REWARD: The righthander has struggled with runners in scoring position and two outs, as opponents are batting .357 (5-14) with seven RBI in these situations.
