## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (27-25) vs. VERMONT LAKE MONSTERS (19-33)

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones defeated the Vermont Lake Monsters 5-4 in walk off fashion on Wednesday night at MCU Park...OF **Gene Cone** went 3-for-5 with a run scored a two RBI, including a squeeze bunt in the 9th that won the game for Brooklyn...2B **Nick Sergakis** added a pair of RBI...Brooklyn used seven pitchers, with none tossing more than 2.0 innings with RHP **Joe Zanghi** (1-0) getting the win.

**LATE TO THE PARTY:** The Cyclones have been outscored 69-37 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 18-9 when they score first and 9-16 when the opposition scores first.

**TAKING OFFENSE:** BKLYN ranks 13th in the NYPL in 159th out of 160 MiLB teams with a .214 (365-1707) team average...Batavia is last in the league and last in MiLB with a .209 (342-1636) average.

**ALL-STARS:** 1B **Pete Alonso**, SS **Colby Woodmansee** and RHP **Harol Gonzalez** were all named to the NYPL All-Star Team and will be members of the South All-Stars on Tuesday, August 16th at Hudson Valley...In the 11 year history of the NYPL All-Star Game, a Brooklyn Cyclone pitcher has started the game on six occasions.

**HOT AS A PISTOL PETE:** 1B **Pete Alonso** has four multi-hit games in his last six starts and is batting .423 (11-26) over the span...Seven of these 11 hits have gone for extra bases - six double and one home run...Brooklyn is 11-0 this season when Alonso has an RBI...The former Florida Gator is batting .400 (14-35) in nine games during the month of August...Alonso injured his left pinky finger on a slide at second base on Tuesday night and will be seen by doctors today.

**vs. VERMONT:** The Cyclones lead the all-time series with the Vermont Expos / Lake Monsters 57-27...The Cyclones are 28-14 at Centennial Field and 29-13 at MCU Park...Brooklyn lost the season series last year, 2-4 but went 15-3 against the Lake Monsters from 2012-2014...Brooklyn took two-of-three games from the Lake Monsters earlier this season (7/28-7/30).

**GETTING ON:** Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 12 of his 13 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has a .469 on-base percentage.

**HOME WRECKERS:** Brooklyn is 14-13 at MCU Park this season and is batting .211 (189-897)...The team has scored 82 runs in 27 games at home (3.03 per game)...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 14 of their last 18 home games, and two runs or less in 12 of 27 games this season.

**WALK THIS WAY:** Last night's was Brooklyn's third walkoff win of the season...The Cyclones also had walkoff wins on June 27th vs. Hudson Valley and July 26th vs. Staten Island in the second game of a doubleheader.

**JOSE IN BK:** INF **Jose Reyes** will join the Cyclones on a Major League Rehabilitation Assignment this evening...He will be 21st Mets to rehab with Brooklyn and the first since RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** pitched in Brooklyn in 2014...It will be the second time that Reyes plays for Brooklyn this season, he also played two games with the Cyclones on June 26th and 27th after signing a minor league deal with the Mets on June 25th...Reyes also rehabbed with BKLYN in 2011, going 1-for-3 in his lone game.

**YA DUNN GOOD:** RHP **Justin Dunn** is the highest drafted pitcher to appear for Brooklyn since LHP **Scott Kazmir** made five starts with BKLYN in 2002..The southpaw went 0-1 with a 0.50 ERA, allowing just five hits in 18.0 IP while striking out 34...Kazmir was 15th overall in the 2002 draft.

**LAST OUTING:** Did not factor in the decision on August 5th at Hudson Valley...Tossed 3.0 near-perfect frames allowing just one hit and a walk.

**TRIPLE PLAY:** Was on the mount in the top of the eighth on July 10th vs. Hudson Valley when Brooklyn turned the first triple play in franchise history. (2-6-4).

**SOARING EAGLE:** Went 4-2 with a 2.06 ERA in 18 games, 8 starts with Boston College this season...Struck out 72 batters in 65.2 innings on the mound...Was named 3rd Team All-America following the season.

**START TO FINISH:** Began the season as the closer for BC, before transitioning to the starting rotation...Went 3-1 as a starter in 2016.
