LAST GAME: The Cyclones bats exploded in a 14-7 victory over the West Virginia Black Bears in the first meeting in Brooklyn between the franchises...The Cyclones matched their season-high with 14 runs...Brooklyn scored eight runs in the bottom of the eighth, all with two outs, to take control of the game.

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 74-38 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-9 when they score first and 10-17 when the opposition scores first.

ONCE IN A BLUE MOON: Last night, RHP **Austin McGeorge** allowed a three-run home run to Matt Diorio in the top of the ninth that provided the winning margin for West Virginia...It was the first run that RHP **Austin McGeorge** has ever allowed in organized baseball...The righthander did not allow a home run in 83.0 innings with Long Beach State and did not allow a home run during his four years at Canyon HS.

BREAKING THE ICE: After going hitless for a calendar month, OF **Hengelbert Rojas** is 5-for-12 over his last three games with three RBI...The three game hitting streak is tied for his season-high.

GETTING ON: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 14 of his 15 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has a .458 on-base percentage.

TI-BEARING IT UP: 3B **Blake Tiberi** has hit safely in six straight games and has six RBI over this span...The 3rd round selection is batting .381 (8-21) during the streak...Since July 16th, he has hit safely in 16 of 21 games and is batting .303 (20-66) over the span.

vs. WEST VIRGINIA: The 2015 season was West Virginia's first year as a NYPL franchise...Brooklyn was swept in a three-game series in Morgantown and is 1-4 all-time against the Black Bears...This weekend is West Virginia's first trip to Brooklyn...The Cyclones went 23-22, including 12-8 against the Jamestown Jammers - the franchise that moved to West Virginia prior to the 2015 season.

KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR: 1B **Darryl Knight** has hit safely in four straight games and is batting .400 (6-15) over the span...The four game hitting streak is tied for the longest of his career...He had two, four-game hitting streaks during the 2014 season with the GCL Mets: one was his first four games as a professional from June 23, 2014 - June 30, 2014, and the other was his last four games of the 2014 season July 14 - 21.

AWESOME ALI: C **Ali Sanchez** is 7-for-13 over his last three games with three doubles...This comes after a stretch in which he was just 2-for-32 over a span of 10 games.

K-OLBY: Cyclones SS **Colby Woodmansee** is tied for third in the NYPL with 56 strikeouts in 157 at-bats this season...The former Arizona State Sun Devil has 18 games with multiple strikeouts including seven contests with three k's...He is hitting .397 (48-121) when he puts the ball in play.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: Brooklyn is currently tied for the NYPL lead with a .978 team fielding percentage...Brooklyn has 48 errors in 2,180 total chances over their 55 games..SS **Colby Woodmansee** leads all NYPL shortstops with a .984 fielding percentage, with just three errors in 189 total chances.

OPENING UP: Was the Cyclones Opening Day starter on June 17th vs. Staten Island...Did not factor in the decision...The Cyclones lost 3-2 in 20 innings.

YOU SHALL NOT PASS: Has issued just one walk over his last 30.2 innings on the mound...Has never walked more than two batters in any appearance as a professional...For his career, has walked just 19 batters 115.2 innings of the mound.

IN THE GENES: Gabriel's father - Pedro Llanes - was a 1st round selection (25th overall) in the 1984 MLB January Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Los Angeles-Harbor College...Pitched in the Minor Leagues for four seasons, going 17-33 with 5.35 ERA...Was selected two picks prior to the Mets taking SS Kevin Elster.
