LAST GAME: The Cyclones lost a slopfest on Staten Island Wednesday night, falling by the score of 4-3...Four of the seven runs scored were unearned and the game featured five errors, three wild pitches, and two passed balls...Brooklyn tied it in the top of the ninth on a **Gene Cone** single but Yancarlos Baez broke the tie with only his 2nd hit of the season, an RBI single, in the bottom of the frame.

GAME OF INCHES: BKLYN and Staten Island have split the first six games of their season series 3-3... Five of these six games have been decided by one run and three of the five have gone to extra innings

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 74-39 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-10 when they score first and 11-17 when the opposition scores first.

BREAKING THE ICE: After going hitless for a calendar month, OF **Hengelbert Rojas** is 6-for-13 over his last four games with three RBI...The four game hitting streak is his longest since a five-game streak with the GCL Mets from 7/18/14 - 7/24/14.

GETTING ON: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 15 of his 16 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has a .476 on-base percentage.

2 for 1: Cyclones infielder **Michael Paez** is 3-for-39 (.077) dating to August 5th.

KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR: 1B **Darryl Knight** has hit safely in seven straight games and is batting .385 (10-26) over the span...The current streak is the longest of his career...He had two, four-game hitting streaks during the 2014 season.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 103-97...Brooklyn is 55-46 all-time at MCU Park and 48-51 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series last year 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...The 2016 series is tied 3-3 with Brooklyn going 3-1 at home and 0-2 on the road so far.

CONE COMING ON: Cyclones OF **Gene Cone** has hit safely in nine of his last 12 and is batting .295 (13-44) over this span...Over his last 18 games, the table setter has scored 15 runs.

K-OLBY: Cyclones SS **Colby Woodmansee** is tied for second in the NYPL with 61 strikeouts in 184 at-bats this season...The former Arizona State Sun Devil has 20 games with multiple strikeouts including eight contests with three k's...He is hitting .398 (49-123) when he puts the ball in play...In 13 games during August, Woodmansee has 21 strikeouts in 53 at-bats.

TI-BEARING IT UP: Since July 16th, 3B **Blake Tiberi** has hit safely in 17 of 23 games and is batting .288 (21-73) over the span.

RIZZIE: Dating to July 26th, Cyclones C **Dan Rizzie** is batting .040 (1-25) and is 2 for his last 37.

PUNCHER'S CHANCE: INF/OF **Jay Jabs** is batting .113 (8-71) since July 14th and has just two multi-hit games since July 2nd.

INJURY BUG: OF **Jacob Zanon** (shoulder) and 1B **Pete Alonso** (finger) are done for the season...INF **Nick Sergakis** (shoulder) and OF **Arnaldo Berrios** (knee) are both considered day-to-day...Zanon and Alonso have both left the team and will return to action during the Instructional League in Florida.

JUSTIN CREDIBLE: RHP **Justin Dunn** has allowed just one hit over his last seven innings on the mound and has not allowed an earned run since July 17th at Hudson Valley...His lone earn run allowed came on a ball that OF Hengelbert Rojas loas in the sun.

YA DUNN GOOD: RHP **Justin Dunn** is the highest drafted pitcher to appear for Brooklyn since LHP **Scott Kazmir** made five starts with BKLYN in 2002..The southpaw went 0-1 with a 0.50 ERA, allowing just five hits in 18.0 IP while striking out 34...Kazmir was 15th overall in 2002.

TRIPLE PLAY: Was on the mount in the top of the eighth on July 10th vs. Hudson Valley when Brooklyn turned the first triple play in franchise history. (2-6-4).

SOARING EAGLE: Went 4-2 with a 2.06 ERA in 18 games, 8 starts with Boston College this season...Struck out 72 batters in 65.2 innings on the mound...Was named 3rd Team All-America following the season.

START TO FINISH: Began the season as the closer for BC, before transitioning to the starting rotation...Went 3-1 as a starter in 2016.
