**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones rallied from an early 5-0 deficit to win 7-5 at Staten Island on Thursday night...Three Cyclones relievers combined to toss 6.0 shutout frames...2B **Jay Jabs** went 2-for-4 with a two-RBI single in the eighth that provided the winning margin.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones rallied from a five-run deficit to win...It was their largest deficit over come of the 2016 season...2B **Jay Jabs** went 2-for-4, it was his first multi-hit game since July 24th and his first RBI since July 29th.

**GAME OF INCHES:** The Cyclones lead the 2016 series over the Yankees 4-3...Five of the seven games have been decided by one run and three of the seven have gone to extra innings.

**LATE TO THE PARTY:** The Cyclones have been outscored 78-39 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-10 when they score first and 12-17 when the opposition scores first.

**LIND-SANITY:** Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 16 of his 17 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has a .463 on-base percentage.

**KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR:** 1B **Darryl Knight** is batting .313 (10-32) during the month of August and has reached base safely in eight straight games dating to August 8th.

**CONE-Y ISLAND:** Cyclones OF **Gene Cone** has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 and is batting .286 (14-49) over this span...Over his last 19 games, the table setter has scored 16 runs...Cone has reached base safely in 14 straight games, every game during the month of August.

**vs. STATEN ISLAND:** The Cyclones lead the all-time series 104-97...Brooklyn is 55-46 all-time at MCU Park and 49-51 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series last year 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...Brooklyn leads the 2016 season series 4-3, going 3-1 at MCU Park and 1-2 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** C **Anthony Dimino** and INF **Franklin Correa** have joined the Cyclones from Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...Dimino, was hitting .325 (38-117) with 18 runs scored, seven doubles, one home run and 15 RBI with the K-Mets while splitting time at 1B, C and DH...Correa, who began the year with Brooklyn was hitting .214 (27-126) with seven doubles, two triples and three home runs...He appeared in two games with Brooklyn in June, one in the infield and one on the mound.

**K-OLBY:** Cyclones SS **Colby Woodmansee** is tied for second in the NYPL with 62 strikeouts...The former Arizona State Sun Devil has 20 games with multiple strikeouts including eight contests with three k's...In 14 games during August, Woodmansee has 22 strikeouts in 56 at-bats...He has at least one strikeout in 14 of his last 15 games.

**RIZZIE:** Dating to July 26th, Cyclones C **Dan Rizzie** is batting .034 (1-29) and is 2 for his last 41.

**INJURY BUG:** OF **Jacob Zanon** (shoulder), 1B **Pete Alonso** (finger), and **Nick Sergakis** (shoulder) are done for the season...OF **Arnaldo Berrios** (knee) is considered day-to-day...Zanon and Alonso have both left the team and will return to action during the Instructional League in Florida.
