LAST GAME: The Spinners completed a three-game sweep of the Cyclones with a 8-1 win on Monday night in Lowell...Brooklyn's lone run came on a **Colby Woodmansee** fielder's choice in the first inning before Lowell scored eight unanswered runs...RHP **Merandy Gonzalez** (4-3) got the loss.

NO E'S IN WIN: Brooklyn set a franchise record with six errors in last night's loss at Lowell...The previous mark was five errors, set twice during the 2015 season...The Cyclones have at least one error in seven straight games and are 2-5 over the span.

NO SWEEP 'TILL BROOKLYN: The Lowell Spinners completed a six-game season sweep of the Cyclones ...It marked only the second time in franchise history that Brooklyn has been swept in a series of six or more games, joining the Tri City Valley Cats who went 6-0 against Brooklyn during the 2009 season.

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 86-44 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-13 when they score first and 12-18 when the opposition scores first.

LIND-SANITY: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 19 of his 20 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has reached base safely in 17 consecutive games.

KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR: 1B **Darryl Knight** is batting .300 (12-40) during the month of August and has reached base safely in 10 straight games dating to August 8th.

TI-BEARING IT UP: 3B **Blake Tiberi** is batting .295 (13-44) with 12 RBI over his last 12 games.

vs. MV SCRAPPERS: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against Mahoning Valley 27-20...The Scrappers have not played in Brooklyn since 2013 when they took two of three from BKLYN...The Cyclones are 12-9 all-time against the Scrappers at MCU Park...The Cyclones and Scrappers played the first game at KeySpan / MCU Park on June 25, 2001 with Brooklyn winning 3-2.

ALL-TIME LOWS: The 2016 Cyclones are on pace to have the lowest team batting average and the highest team ERA in franchise history...Brooklyn is currently hitting .215 as a team and has a 3.42 ERA...The previous low marks in franchise history was a .220 average in 2015 and a 3.41 ERA in 2005...Since 2001, no NYPL team has hit below .215...Brooklyn currently ranks 159th out of 160 MiLB teams in team batting, ahead of Batavia (.209)...No other team in MiLB is batting under .229.

SLUMPIN AT SECOND: Cyclones 2B **Michael Paez** is 4-for-59 (.068) dating to August 5th...The fourth round pick from Coastal Carolina has just three multi-hit games all season and has at least one strikeout in 11 of his last 12 games.

ALL ABOUT ALONSO: Brooklyn has gone 5-6 since 1B **Pete Alonso** broke his finger and was ruled out for the remainder of the season...For the year, Brooklyn is 14-18 with Alonso out of the lineup and 17-13 when the 2nd round pick from the Univ. of Florida was in the starting nine.

MENDOZA LINE: The Cyclones currently have four players with at least 107 at-bats who are hitting under .200: OF **Arnaldo Berrios** (.196), INF **Jay Jabs** (.184), IF **Michael Paez** (.154) and OF **Jacob Zanon** (.197)...The rest of the NYPL has just five players who are hitting under .200 with at-least 107 at-bats.

WORLD BASEBALL: Is on the 35-man roster for Team Israel for WBC Qualifier coming to Brooklyn this fall.

PRODIGAL SON: Was transferred to Columbia on July 27th...Returned to Brooklyn on August 9th after making two starts with the Fireflies.

START ME UP: His last start with Brooklyn came on July 26th vs. Staten Island in the second game of a doubleheader...Tossed 5.0 shutout frames but did not factor in the decision as Brooklyn rallied to win 3-2 in extra innings.

START ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Leadoff batters are hitting just .156 (5-32) against him without any walks this season.

ALRIGHT ALRIGHT: Righthanded batters are hitting .164 (12-73) against him with two extra base hits, including the only home run he has allowed this season.
