LAST GAME: The Cyclones snapped their four game losing streak with a 2-1 victory over the Scrappers in 11 innings on Tuesday night...1B **Anthony Dimino** had an RBI single in the bottom of the 11th to plate **Jay Jabs** and give BKLYN the win... RHP **Raul Jacobson** struck out a career-high eight.

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 87-44 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-13 when they score first and 13-18 when the opposition scores first.

LIND-SANITY: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 20 of his 21 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has reached base safely in 18 consecutive games.

KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR: 1B **Darryl Knight** is batting .300 (12-40) during the month of August and has reached base safely in 10 straight games dating to August 8th.

ALL-TIME LOW: The 2016 Cyclones are on pace to have the lowest team batting average in franchise history...Brooklyn is currently hitting .215 as a team...The previous low marks in franchise history was a .220 average in 2015...Since 2001, no NYPL team has hit below .215...Brooklyn currently ranks 159th out of 160 MiLB teams in team batting, ahead of Batavia (.209)...No other team in MiLB is batting under .229.

SLUMPIN AT SECOND: Cyclones 2B **Michael Paez** is 5-for-64 (.078) dating to August 5th...The fourth round pick from Coastal Carolina has just three multi-hit games all season and has just one RBI since August 5th...He is 3-for-30 (.100) since the All-Star Break.

vs. MV SCRAPPERS: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against Mahoning Valley 28-20...The Scrappers have not played in Brooklyn since 2013 when they took two of three from BKLYN...The Cyclones are 13-9 all-time against the Scrappers at MCU Park...The Cyclones and Scrappers played the first game at KeySpan / MCU Park on June 25, 2001 with Brooklyn winning 3-2 in 10 innings.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn improved to 14-10 in one one games with last night's win...The 24 one run games are tied with Williamsport (15-9) for most in the NYPL.

HOME COOKIN': The Cyclones are 12-4 at MCU Park since July 21st including 6-1 in their last seven contests.

COLD COLBY: SS **Colby Woodmansee** is batting .186 (13-70) during the month of August with 25 strikeouts...He is 6-for-38 (.158) since August 11th.

ALL ABOUT ALONSO: Brooklyn has gone 6-6 since 1B **Pete Alonso** broke his finger and was ruled out for the remainder of the season...For the year, Brooklyn is 15-18 with Alonso out of the lineup and 17-13 when the 2nd round pick from the Univ. of Florida was in the starting nine.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: RHP **Rob Gsellman** got the win in his Major League Debut with the Mets last night, becoming the 61st former Cyclone to make the climb to the Major Leagues...Gsellman was an NYPL All-Star with Brooklyn in 2013, going 3-3 with a 2.06 ERA in 12 starts.

BERRI-O's: OF **Arnaldo Berrios** comes into tonight's game hiteless in his last 14 at bats and does not have a base hit since July 30th...The outfielder has been nursing an injured knee since July 31st.

JUSTIN CREDIBLE: RHP Justin Dunn has allowed just two hits over 8.0 shutout innings over his three appearances at MCU Park...The righthander has 12 strikeouts in these three games, two starts.

YA DUNN GOOD: RHP Justin Dunn is the highest drafted pitcher to appear for Brooklyn since LHP Scott Kazmir made five starts with BKLYN in 2002..The southpaw went 0-1 with a 0.50 ERA, allowing just five hits in 18.0 IP while striking out 34...Kazmir was 15th overall in 2002.

TRIPLE PLAY: Was on the mount in the top of the eighth on July 10th vs. Hudson Valley when Brooklyn turned the first triple play in franchise history. (2-6-4).

SOARING EAGLE: Went 4-2 with a 2.06 ERA in 18 games, 8 starts with Boston College this season...Struck out 72 batters in 65.2 innings on the mound...Was named 3rd Team All-America following the season.

START TO FINISH: Began the season as the closer for BC, before transitioning to the starting rotation...Went 3-1 as a starter in 2016.
