LAST GAME: The Cyclones fell to Mahoning Valley 5-1 on Thursday night at MCU Park...RHP **Erik Manoah** (5-4) suffered the loss after allowing four runs, earned, on six hits over 3.2 IP...2B **Franklin Correa** went 2-for-4 and also tossed 1.0 scoreless inning of relief.

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 87-44 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 19-13 when they score first and 13-20 when the opposition scores first.

LIND-SANITY: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 22 of his 23 games this season, with an 0-for-2 effort on July 26th as the only game in which he did not reach...The 2015 2nd round draft pick has reached base safely in 20 consecutive games dating to July 28th.

ALL-TIME LOW: The 2016 Cyclones are on pace to have the lowest team batting average in franchise history...Brooklyn is currently hitting .214 as a team...The previous low mark in franchise history was a .220 average in 2015...Since 2001, no NYPL team has hit below .215...Brooklyn currently ranks 159th out of 160 MiLB teams in team batting, ahead of Batavia (.212).

ALL-STAR BROKEN: Brooklyn is 2-7 since the All-Star break and are batting just .182 (54-296) over this span...The Cyclones have been outscored 46-27 over the span, scoring two runs or less in five of these nine games.

SLUMPIN AT SECOND: Cyclones 2B **Michael Paez** is 6-for-67 (.090) dating to August 5th...The fourth round pick from Coastal Carolina has just three multi-hit games all season and has two RBI since August 5th...He is 4-for-33 (.121) since the ASG.

vs. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Crosscutters 43-27...Brooklyn is 6-0 against Williamsport over the last two seasons and has not lost to the 'Cutters since July 31, 2013... The Cyclones are 18-13 all-time in Williamsport and have made just one trip to BB & T Ballpark in the last five seasons, going 1-2 there in 2013...These two teams were declared Co-Champions in 2001.

GONZO THE GREAT: Tonight's starter RHP **Harol Gonzalez** currently leads the NYPL with 77 strikeouts...A Cyclone has led the NYPL in K's every year since 2012.

EIGHT ISN'T ENOUGH: Brooklyn had a 5-4 lead after eight innings on Wednesday, and lost 6-5 to the Scrappers...It marked the second time this season that the Cyclones had a lead after eight, but lost the game...Coming into 2016, BKLYN only had 14 losses in franchise history when leading after eight innings.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: The Cyclones are batting .212 as a team during August and are 11-12 with a 3.79 team ERA...In 2015, Brooklyn went 9-20 during August with a .220 average and a 4.03 ERA.

COLD COLBY: SS **Colby Woodmansee** is batting .203 (16-79) during the month of August with 26 strikeouts...He is 9-for-47 (.191) since August 11th.

BERRI-O's: OF **Arnaldo Berrios** comes into tonight's game hiteless in his last 14 at bats and does not have a base hit since July 30th...The outfielder has been nursing an injured knee since July 31st.

BROOKLYN BACKSTOPS: The combination of **Ali Sanchez, Dan Rizzie, Brandon Brosher** and **Darryl Knight** have caught all 65 games for the Cyclones this season...Combined, these four backstops are batting .208 (48-231) as catchers this season.

LAST START: Suffered his first loss in almost two months, dropping his decision at Lowell on August 20th...Allowed three runs, two earned, over 5.0 IP on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts in a game Brooklyn lost 4-1.

ALL-STAR: Was awarded the win in the NYPL All-Star Game at Hudson Valley on August 16th...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning.

SHUT EM DOWN: Had a 20.2 inning scoreless streak snapped in the bottom of the third on July 28th at Vermont...Has allowed just four runs over his last 42.2 innings on the mound.

AL-RIGHT, AL-RIGHT, AL-RIGHT: Righthanded batters are jitting just .174 (21-121) against him with five extra base hits.

FORCE OF JULY: Went 2-0 with a 1.72 ERA over five starts in the month of July...Over his last 32.2 innings, spanning five starts, has allowed just two runs (0.59).

LEADER OF THE PACK: Leads the New York-Penn League with 77 strikeouts...A BKLYN pitcher has led the NYPL in strikeouts every season since 2012...Ranks third in the NYPL with a 0.93 WHIP and fourth with a .198 opponents batting average...The .198 average ranks lowest among pitchers who have performed exclusively as starters.

DOUBLE DIGIT STRIKEOUTS: Struck out 11 batters in his start on July 28th at Vermont...Also recorded double digit k's on June 28th at SC and July 3rd vs. CT...RHP **Brad Holt** holds the franchise record with four double-digit strikeout games in a season (2008).
