LAST GAME: Brooklyn scored twice in the seventh, thanks to a bases loaded walk of **Hengelbert Rojas** and an RBI single from **Arnaldo Berrios** to rally for a 2-1 victory in the rubber game at Williamsport...RHP **Merandy Gonzalez** (5-3) got the win after tossing 6.1 innings, allowing one run.

DEUCE IS WILD: The Cyclones have scored two runs or less in four straight contests and eight of their last 10...Brooklyn has scored two runs or fewer in 30 of 68 games this season.

LATE TO THE PARTY: The Cyclones have been outscored 90-44 in the first two innings of the game...Brooklyn is 20-13 when they score first and 14-21 when the opposition scores first.

LIND-SANITY: Cyclones OF **Desmond Lindsay** has reached base safely in 24 of his 26 games this season, and had a 20 game on-base streak snapped with an 0-for-4 on Saturday at WPT.

ALL-TIME LOW: The 2016 Cyclones are on pace to have the lowest team batting average in franchise history...Brooklyn is currently hitting .212 as a team which ranks last in all of Minor League Baseball...Since the Cyclones joined the New York-Penn League in 2001, no team has ever hit below .215 (Vermont Expos, 2003).

ALL-STAR BROKEN: Brooklyn is 4-8 since the All-Star break and are batting just .178 (70-391) over this span.

SLUMPIN AT SECOND: Cyclones 2B **Michael Paez** is 7-for-79 (.089) dating to August 5th...The fourth round pick from Coastal Carolina has just three multi-hit games all season and has two RBI since August 5th...He is 5-for-45 (.111) since the ASG.

vs. AUBURN: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Doubledays 27-20 including an 18-7 record here at MCU Park...Since 2007, Brooklyn is 12-3 against the Doubledays in Brooklyn...Auburn leads the series at Falcon Park 13-9...The Doubledays have not won a series at MCU Park since the 2005 season when they went 2-1, and have won just two series in Brooklyn all-time.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: The Cyclones are batting .207 as a team during August and are 13-13 with a 3.56 team ERA...In 2015, Brooklyn went 9-20 during August with a .220 average and a 4.03 ERA.

COLD COLBY: SS **Colby Woodmansee** is batting .198 (18-91) during the month of August with 30 strikeouts.

HOME COOKIN': The Cyclones are 18-16 at MCU Park, with a 2.76 team ERA...Brooklyn is 16-18 on the road with a 4.04 ERA.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Prior to the All-Star Break, the Cyclones were tied for the NYPL lead with a .978 team fielding percentage, with 48 errors in 2,223 total chances through 56 games...Since the All-Star break, the Cyclones have 25 errors in 12 games and a fielding percentage of .944 (25-446).

BROOKLYN BACKSTOPS: The combination of **Ali Sanchez, Dan Rizzie, Brandon Brosher** and **Darryl Knight** have caught all 68 games for the Cyclones this season...Combined, these four backstops are batting .212 (51-241) as catchers this season.

GET THE LEAD OUT: Brooklyn is batting .199 (24-558) to lead off an inning with a .283 on-base percentage...Both numbers are the lowest in the NYPL.

LAST OUTING: Did not factor in the decision, but struck out a career-high eight batters over 6.0 IP, allowing one run, earned, on three hits...Retired the last 12 batters he faced.. Brooklyn would go on to win 2-1 in 11 innings.

HOME COOKIN': Is 1-1 with a save in six appearances at home...Has allowed five runs in 26.1 innings at home for a 2.05 ERA.

PRODIGAL SON: Was transferred to Columbia on July 27th...Returned to Brooklyn on August 9th after making two starts with the Fireflies.

START ME UP: In his two starts this season (7/26 vs. SI and 8/23 vs. MV) is 0-0 with a 0.82 ERA...Has allowed just one run on five hits over 11.0 IP without a walk while striking out 12.

START ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Leadoff batters are hitting just .158 (6-38) against him without any walks this season.

ALRIGHT ALRIGHT: Righthanded batters are hitting .163 (14-86) against him with two extra base hits, including the only home run he has allowed this season.

RISP REWARD: Has limited opponents to a .138 (4-29) average with runners in scoring position...The opposition is batting just .077 (1-13) with RISP and two outs.
