LAST GAME: For the second time in three games, the Cyclones were shutout as they fell to the Aberdeen IronBirds by the score of 2-0 at MCU Park on Tuesday afternoon...Brooklyn managed just seven hits in the three-game series with Aberdeen and has scored just two runs over their last four games...RHP **Gabriel Llanes** (2-5) was the hard luck loser after allowing just one run on five hits over 8.0 IP.

HE'S PETE-ING UP: The Cyclones are 9-0 when 1B **Pete Alonso** has an RBI..Alonso is now batting .455 (10-22) with RISP and .500 (8-16) with RISP and two outs.

NEED FOR SPEED: OF **Jacob Zanon** currently leads the New York-Penn League in stolen bases with 18...The last Cyclone to steal more than 18 bases in a season was OF **Darrell Ceciliani** who swiped 21 during the 2010 season...The franchise record for steals was set by OF **Angel Pagan** who stole 30 bags in 2001.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn is 12-14 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 11-9 in one-run games and 1-5 in two-run games... The 20 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL.

IN A DAYS: Brooklyn is 16-4 in Sunday - Tuesday games and is 6-18 from Wednesday - Saturday.

ROSTER MOVE: C **Brandon Brosher** has re-joined the Cyclones...Brosher hit .167 (5-30) in 11 games with the Columbia Fireflies after starting the year in Brooklyn and batting .232 (13- 56) in 14 games.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Renegades 90-68... Brooklyn has lost only one season series to the Renegades (2010)...Brooklyn is 52-29 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Gades and are 38-39 on the road...The 90 wins against the Renegades are the second most in franchise history, behind the 103 wins Brooklyn has against Staten Island.

SHUT IT DOWN Last night was the fifth time Brooklyn has been shut out, all coming at MCU Park... Since the start of 2015, Brooklyn has been shut out 13 times, 12 of them have come at home.

THE GREAT GONZO: Tonight's starter RHP **Harol Gonzalez** is 10th in the NYPL with a 2.02 ERA, ranks fourth in opponent batting average (.188) and fifth in WHIP (0.90)...He also leads the NYPL with 63 strikeouts...A Cyclone pitcher has led the NYPL in strikeouts every season since 2012.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones Manager **Tom Gamboa** comes into tonight's game with 97 wins as manager of the Cyclones...He would become just the third manager in franchise history to eclipse the 100 win mark, joining **Edgar Alfonzo** (146 wins) and **Rich Donnelly** (128 wins).

GOOD WOOD: SS **Colby Woodmansee** leads all NYPL shortstops with a .986 fielding percentage... He has just two errors in 145 chances and has just one error since July 2nd.

A RUNNING START: The Renegades have swiped 25 bases and been caught 11 times (69.4%) in nine games against Brooklyn in 2016...The Renegades have 85 stolen bases against Brooklyn over their last four seasons (43 games).

BACK 2 BACK: Became the first pitcher since 2014 with double digit strikeouts in back-to-back contests...RHP **Casey Meisner** (8/17 at VER and 8/26 at SI) and RHP **Marcos Molina** (8/09 at BAT and 8/15 at VER) were the last to accomplish the feat.
