BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Brooklyn scored one run in the ninth inning last night and have now scored 30 of their 60 runs (50%) in the seventh inning or later.

HITS KEEP ON COMING: LHP Joel Huertas allowed 12 hits over his 5.1 innings on the mound, to tie the franchise record for most hits allowed in a game...RHP Andrew Church also allowed 12 hits in a game on August 22, 2015 at Aberdeen in a game the Cyclones won 12-9.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Last night's contest was only the third game this season that has been decided by more than two runs...Brooklyn is 4-5 in one run games and 0-2 in two-run games...The Cyclones are now 2-1 in games decided by +3 runs.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** Through their first 14 contests of the season, Brooklyn has played a NYPL leading five extra inning games, going 1-4 in these contests...Brooklyn played a franchise record 13 extra inning games in 2002, going 7-6 in these contests.

**DUNN DEBUT: RHP Justin Dunn**, the Mets 1st selection in the 2016 MLB Draft (19th overall) out of Boston College is expected to make his professional debut in relief on Monday at Batavia.

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones saw and early 3-1 lead vs. CONNECTICUT: The Connecticut Tigers lead slip aways as Brooklyn starter LHP Joel Huertas the all-time series with the Cyclones 20-19...Since 2001, the Tigers are the only team to play the Cyclones more than three times and not have a losing record...Brooklyn is 10-7 all-time at MCU Park against the Tigers and 9-13 at Dodd Stadium in Connecticut...The Tigers took two-of-three games from Brooklyn earlier this season in CT.

> ALRIGHT vs. LEFT: Brooklyn is 3-2 in games started by lefthanded pitching and is batting .253 (37-146) against lefties overall...OF Gene Cone is batting .455 (5-11) against southpaws...The Cyclones are hitting .204 (81-397) against righthanders this season.

> BERRY GOOD: After begining the season in a 0-for-20 slump, OF **Arnaldo Berrios** has hit safely in each of his last five games and is batting .450 (9-20) over the span, including three straight multi-hit games... The switch hitter is still 0-for-10 against lefhanded pitching this season.

> MLB CYCLONES: RHP Seth Lugo, who was a member of the 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones, has been promoted to the New York Mets...Lugo will become the 58th former Cyclone to make it to the major leagues and the 39th to play for the Mets.

> FRANKLY SPEAKING: On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.
