LAST GAME: RHP **Harol Gonzalez** (1-1) did not allow a hit until the top of the seventh, but the Brooklyn bats were silenced even longer as were shutout for the second time this season, falling 1-0...The Cyclones had two runners thrown out at the plate, including SS **Colby Woodmansee** for the final out of the game...Brooklyn went 1-for-7 with RISP and the lone run of the game came home to score of a throwing error from 2B **Michael Paez** in the top of the eighth.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones have hit seven home run in their last five games...Brooklyn hit just five home runs in their first 22 games of the season...The Cyclones are tied for fourth in the NYPL with 12 home runs on the season...Brooklyn's seven home runs in the last four games are more than six teams have hit all season, and equal Lowell's season total.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn is 7-11 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 7-7 in one-run games and 0-4 in two-run games...The 14 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL...Staten Island (7-3) and Hudson Valley (2-8) are tied for second in the league with nine one-run games.

IN A DAYS: Brooklyn is 11-1 on Sunday - Tuesday games and 2-13 from Wednesday - Saturday.

DIGGING A HOLE: The Cyclones have been outscored 52-28 in the first three innings of games this season...From the fourth inning on, they have outscored opponents, 80-60.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Spinner 47-31...Brooklyn is 24-15 at MCU Park and 23-16 on the road in Lowell...The Cyclones have not lost a home series to the Spinners since 2012...Since 2010 Brooklyn has gone 23-12 against Lowell...Lowell Spinners manager Iggy Suarez was born in Corona, NY.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The Cyclones have scored 46 of their 108 runs in the 7th inning or later (42.6%).

PETE'S GOT HEAT: 1B **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in each of his first six games to begin his professional career...The 2nd round pick from the University of Florida also has four runs scored, three doubles, one home run and five RBI...The former Gator is batting .625 (5-8) with RISP and .800 (4-5) with RISP and 2 outs.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones currently rank fourth in the NYPL with a .976 team fielding percentage...Brooklyn has been charged with 27 errors in 1,128 total chances...The 1,128 total chances are the most in the league with Staten Island ranking second with 1,080.

KINGS OF K's: Brooklyn pitchers lead the NYPL with 271 strikeouts in 263.2 innings pitched...Staten Island ranks second with 257 in 257.0 innings...RHP Harol Gonzalez leads the league with 43 punchouts...A Cyclones starting pitcher has led the league in strikeouts every season season 2012. (Luis Mateo: 85 ('12), Miller Diaz: 87 ('13), Marcos Molina: 91 ('14) and Kevin Canelon: 70 ('15). Cyclones pitchers finished 1st and 2nd in 2012 - 2014.
