BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Brooklyn scored one run in the 10th inning last night and have now scored 31 of their 63 runs (49.2%) in the seventh inning or later.

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones played their sixth ex- vs. CONNECTICUT: The Connecticut Tigers lead tra inning contest in 15 games to start the season, the all-time series with the Cyclones 21-19...Since 2001, the Tigers are the only team to play the Cyclones more than three times and not have a losing record...Brooklyn is 10-8 all-time at MCU Park against the Tigers and 9-13 at Dodd Stadium in Connecticut...The Tigers took two-of-three games from Brooklyn earlier this season in CT.
