LAST GAME: The Cyclones lost the rubber match of a three-game series with the Renegades on Wednesday night at Dutchess Stadium by the score of 3-2...A Brooklyn error in the bottom of the fifth led to a pair of runs for the 'Gades...The Cyclones went 0-for-10 with RISP and were held to five hits overall.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn is 7-12 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 7-8 in one-run games and 0-4 in two-run games... The 15 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL...Hudson Valley ranks second with 11 one-run games

IN A DAYS: Brooklyn is 12-2 on Sunday - Tuesday games and 2-16 from Wednesday - Saturday.

SOMETHING TWO WORRY ABOUT: Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in seven of their last 13 games dating to July 16th...Brooklyn is 5-8 over this span and has been outscored 55-38.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Brooklyn is one of just three teams in the NYPL to not reach double digits in runs this season...Aberdeen (9) and Vermont (8) are the other teams...The Cyclones scored a season-high nine runs in an 17 inning contest with the ValleyCats on June 20th, a game they lost 10-9...Brooklyn has scored more than six runs on one occasion in a nine inning game.

DIGGING A HOLE: The Cyclones have been outscored 59-33 in the first three innings of games this season...From the fourth inning on, they have outscored opponents, 87-74.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the IronBirds 87-54...Brooklyn is 46-25 at Ripken Stadium and 41-29 at MCU Park...Since 2013 the series is tied 13-13...Brooklyn won or split the season series with the IronBirds every year from 2002-2012, with Aberdeen taking the 2013 series 7-3...Brooklyn is 3-0 against Aberdeen this season after sweeping a series from July 11 - 13 in MD.

WHO'S HOT/ WHO'S NOT: 3B **Blake Tiberi** has hit safely in four straight games and is batting .417 (5-12) over the span...INF/ OF **Jay Jabs** is batting just .158 (9-57) during July...INF **Nick Sergakis** is hitting .188 (9-48) for the month.

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .232 (65-280) with RISP, including their 0-for-10 effort on Wednesday evening...The .232 average ranks sixth in the NYPL

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Brooklyn is 10-3 when they score five runs or more in a game.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: Brooklyn is 2-7 at MCU Park during the month of July and has scored just nine runs in their last six home games.

GET THE LEAD OUT: The Cyclones are batting just .195 (53-272) to lead off an inning, lowest in the NYPL...Williamsport leads the league with a .287 (73-254) average to lead off an inning.

FROST OF JULY: Brooklyn is batting just .201 (116-576) in 18 games during the month of July...That is second lowest in the NYPL during the month, ahead of only the Staten Island Yankees who are batting .200 (118-590) during the month.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on July 14th vs. Lowell Spinners...Allowed no runs, on one hit over 6.2 innings walking two and striking out seven...The Cyclones lost the game 1-0.

LEADER OF THE PACK: Leads the New York-Penn League with 43 strikeouts and a 11.27 strikeout / 9 ratio.

10K: Struck out 10 batters on July 3rd vs. CT and June 28th at SC... Became the 40th & 41st pitcher in franchise history to record double digit strikeouts in a game, and the first since LHP **Kevin Canelon** struck out 10 on August 25, 2015 at Hudson Valley.

BACK 2 BACK: Became the first pitcher since 2014 with double digit strikeouts in back-to-back contests...RHP **Casey Meisner** (8/17 at VER and 8/26 at SI) and RHP **Marcos Molina** (8/09 at BAT and 8/15 at VER) were the last to accomplish the feat...RHP **Brad Holt** holds the franchise record with four double-digit strikeout games in a season (2008).

LONG AND SHORT OF IT: Allowed 12 homeruns, most in the Appalachian League in 2015...Allowed three home runs in two separate games on July 15th at Princeton and August 24th at Bristol...Seven of the round trippers were hit by lefthanders.

FIVE AND DRIVE: Ran into most of his trouble after the fifth inning last season...Through the first 5.0 innings of games, he allowed 16 earned runs in 42.1 for a 3.40 ERA...From the sixth inning on, allowed 20 earned runs in just 23 innings for a 7.83 ERA.

KEEP EM OFF THE BASES: Gonzalez allowed the opposition to hit .413 (19-46) with Runners in Scoring Position last year, .333 (31-93) with runners on base and just .224 (37-165) with nobody on base.
