LAST GAME: It was a tale of two games on Friday evening as Brooklyn dominated early, taking a 2-0 lead with RHP **Merandy Gonzalez** (2-2) dominating the IronBirds early...But the IronBirds scored three off of Gonzalez in the sixth and eight off of the Brooklyn bullpen to run away with an 11-2 win.

CLOSE CALLS: Brooklyn is 8-12 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 8-8 in one-run games and 0-4 in two-run games... The 16 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL...Hudson Valley ranks second with 12 one-run games.

IN A DAYS: Brooklyn is 12-2 on Sunday - Tuesday games and 3-17 from Wednesday - Saturday.

SOMETHING TWO WORRY ABOUT: Brooklyn has scored two runs or less in eight of their last 15 games dating to July 6th...Brooklyn is 6-9 over this span and has been outscored 68-43.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Brooklyn is one of just two teams in the NYPL to not reach double digits in runs this season (Vermont)...The Cyclones scored a season-high nine runs in a 17 inning contest with the ValleyCats on June 20th, a game they lost 10-9...Brooklyn has scored more than six runs on one occasion in a nine inning game.

WHO'S HOT/ WHO'S NOT: 3B **Blake Tiberi** has hit safely in six straight games and is batting .444 (8-18) over the span...Tiberi has struck out just one time in his last 22 at-bats, spanning seven games... INF/ OF **Jay Jabs** is batting just .150 (9-60) during July and is 2-for-31 over his last nine games.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the IronBirds 88-55...Brooklyn is 46-25 at Ripken Stadium and 42-30 at MCU Park... Since 2013, the series is tied 14-14...Brooklyn won or split the season series with the IronBirds every year from 2002-2012, with Aberdeen taking the 2013 series 7-3...Brooklyn is 4-0 against Aberdeen this season.

YA DUNN GOOD: RHP **Justin Dunn** will make his first professional start this evening...He is the highest drafted pitcher to appear for Brooklyn since LHP **Scott Kazmir** made five starts with BKLYN in 2002.. The southpaw went 0-1 with a 0.50 ERA, allowing just five hits in 18.0 IP while striking out 34.

HOME WRECKERS: The Cyclones are 7-11 at MCU Park, tied for the most home losses in the NYPL...The team has been outscored 77-58 at home...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less at home 11 different times this season and 26 times over the last two seasons spanning 55 games... Brooklyn is 23-32 at home during this span, after never posting a losing record at home through the first 14 years in franchise history.

MY KINGDOM FOR A HIT: The Cyclones currently rank 157th out of 160 MiLB teams with a .213 team batting average...Only Batavia (.208), the GCL Twins (.206), and GCL Yankees West (.201) have a lower team average...Brooklyn hit .220 as a team last season, the lowest team average in the NYPL since the 2001 Vermont Expos hit .208 as a team.

FROST OF JULY: Brooklyn is batting just .208 (133-638) in 20 games during the month of July...Lowest in the NYPL during the month.

LAST OUTING: Tossed 2.0 innings of relief, allowed one run on three hits on July 17th at Hudson Valley...Two of the three hits were balls that were lost in the sun by OF Hengelbert Rojas.

TRIPLE PLAY: Was on the mount in the top of the eighth on July 10th vs. Hudson Valley when Brooklyn turned the first triple play in franchise history. (2-6-4).

SOARING EAGLE: Went 4-2 with a 2.06 ERA in 18 games, 8 starts with Boston College this season...Struck out 72 batters in 65.2 innings on the mound...Was named 3rd Team All-America following the season.

START TO FINISH: Began the season as the closer for BC, before transitioning to the starting rotation...Went 3-1 as a starter in 2016.
