**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones completed a double header sweep of the Staten Island Yankees on Tuesday night, taking Game One by the score of 2-1 before winning the night cap by the score of 3-2 in extra frames.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** Brooklyn is 4-1 over their last five games and are batting .289 (43-149) over the span...Brooklyn has currently won four straight games, tied for the longest winning streak of the season... Brooklyn last won five games in a row from July 4, 2015 - July 9, 2015...The last streak longer than five games was six straight (June 17, 2014 - June 22, 2014)...The Cyclones are also only 3.0 games out of 1st place for the first time since 6/22.

**POWER SERGE:** INF **Nick Sergakis** has hit safely in four of his alst five games, and is batting .474 (9-19) over this span...The former Ohio State Buckeye has seven multi-hit games this season, including a franchise record five hit game on June 20th vs. Tri-City.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** OF **Jacob Zanon** swiped his 14th base of the season in Gmae One on Tuesday evening...The 14 swipes are the most by a Cyclone since OF **Patrick Biondi** stole 17 bags in 2013...Brooklyn is tied for third in the NYPL with 41 stolen bases as a team, and has been caught just 15 times.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Brooklyn is 10-12 this season in games decided by two runs or less...Brooklyn is 10-8 in one-run games and 0-4 in two-run games... The 18 one-run games are more than any other team in the NYPL.

**vs. VERMONT:** The Cycloneslead the all-time series with the Vermont Expos / Lake Monsters 53-26...The Cyclones are 26-13 at Centennial Field and 27-13 at MCU Park...Brooklyn Last the season series last year, 2-4 but went 15-3 against the Lake Monsters from 2012-2014...Brooklyn has completed series sweeps in Vermont six times in the last 10 years.

**IN A DAYS:** Brooklyn is 15-2 in Sunday - Tuesday games and is 4-17 from Wednesday - Saturday.

**.500 MARK:** With a win tonight, the Cyclones would improve to 20-19 and climb over the .500 mark for the first time this season...The Cyclones have not been above .500 since August 6, 2015 when the team was 23-22...The 2015 season marked the first time in franchise history that the Cyclones finished with a losing record.

**THE HEAT ON PETE:** 1B **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in 14 of 17 games since being selected in the 2nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida...The Cyclones are 6-0 when Pete Alonso has an RBI.

**TIBER-ING IT UP:** 3B **Blake Tiberi** has hit safely in eight of his last nine games and is batting .371 (10-27) over the span to raise his batting average from .177 to .236.

**GOOD WOOD:** SS **Colby Woodmansee** leads all NYPL shortstops with a .992 fielding percentage...The former Arizona State Sun Devil has been charged with just one errore in 127 chances and has played 18 consecutive games at shortstop with a miscue, dating to July 2nd vs. Connecticut.

**LAST START:** Did awarded the win on July 21st vs. Aberdeen Iron-Birds...Allowed no runs, on five hits over 7.2 innings walking one and striking out nine...The Cyclones won the game 3-2.

**LEADER OF THE PACK:** Leads the New York-Penn League with 52 strikeouts and a 11.14 strikeout / 9 ratio.

**10K:** Struck out 10 batters on July 3rd vs. CT and June 28th at SC... Became the 40th & 41st pitcher in franchise history to record double digit strikeouts in a game, and the first since LHP Kevin Canelon struck out 10 on August 25, 2015 at Hudson Valley.

**BACK 2 BACK:** Became the first pitcher since 2014 with double digit strikeouts in back-to-back contests...RHP Casey Meisner (8/17 at VER and 8/26 at SI) and RHP Marcos Molina (8/09 at BAT and 8/15 at VER) were the last to accomplish the feat...RHP Brad Holt holds the franchise record with four double-digit strikeout games in a season (2008).

**LONG AND SHORT OF IT:** Allowed 12 homeruns, most in the Appalachian League in 2015...Allowed three home runs in two separate games on July 15th at Princeton and August 24th at Bristol...Seven of the round trippers were hit by lefthanders.

**FIVE AND DRIVE:** Ran into most of his trouble after the fifth inning last season...Through the first 5.0 innings of games, he allowed 16 earned runs in 42.1 for a 3.40 ERA...From the sixth inning on, allowed 20 earned runs in just 23 innings for a 7.83 ERA.

**KEEP EM OFF THE BASES:** Gonzalez allowed the opposition to hit .413 (19-46) with Runners in Scoring Position last year, .333 (31-93) with runners on base and just .224 (37-165) with nobody on base.
