EXTRA EXTRA: Through their first 16 contests of the season, Brooklyn has played a NYPL leading six extra inning games, going 1-5 in these contests...The Cyclones have never had more than six extra inning losses in a season...The record for most extra inning games in a season is 13 during the 2002 season.

DUNN DEBUT: RHP Justin Dunn, the Mets 1st selection in the 2016 MLB Draft (19th overall) out of Boston College is expected to make his professional debut in relief on Monday at Batavia.

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones dropped their fourth vs. CONNECTICUT: The Connecticut Tigers lead straight game on Saturday night, losing to the the all-time series with the Cyclones 22-19...Since 2001, the Tigers are the only team to play the Cyclones more than three times and not have a losing record...Brooklyn is 10-9 all-time at MCU Park against the Tigers and 9-13 at Dodd Stadium in Connecticut...The Tigers took two-of-three games from Brooklyn earlier this season in CT.

> WHO'S HOT: After beginning the season, 2-for-18, C Brandon Brosher has hit safely in six straight games and is batting .375 (9-24) over this span... Brosher has at least one RBI in five straight game... He is second on the team with 20 strikeouts and is hitting .500 (11-22) when he puts the ball in play.

> WHO'S NOT: Brooklyn 2B Nick Sergakis is hitting just .100 (2-20) over his last five games.

> BERRY GOOD: OF Arnaldo Berrios has hit safely in six of his last seven games, including multi-hit games in four of his last five...After beginning the season 0-20, the 20-year-old is now batting .393 (11-28) over his last seven contests.

> INJURY BUG: INF Dionis Paulino is expected to undergo surgery Tuesday at H.S.S to repair a right shoulder separation.

> FRANKLY SPEAKING: Today, the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous... The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game....Competitive eater, Badlands Booker will throw out a first pitch prior to the start of the game... Brooklyn last changed their name to the Baracklyn Cyclones in 2008 in honor of the President.
