OPENING DAY: The Cyclones are 12-3 all-time on Opening Day and 8-1 since 2007, with their lone loss coming at the hands of the Staten Island Yankees in 2013...This season marks the 13th time that the Cyclones and Yankees will square off on Opening Day with the Cyclones holding a 10-2 advantage in these games...The Cyclones and Staten Island have opened the season against each other every year since 2005.

HOME OPENER: The Cyclones are 12-3 all-time in Home Openers, including 9-3 against the Staten Island Yankees...Brooklyn fell to the Yankees 8-3 to open the home slate last season... One of their three home opener losses was the worst loss in franchise history, as Brooklyn fell to Staten Island 18-0 to open the home schedule in 2006.

REDECORATING: For the 2016 season, the capacity of MCU Park has been lowered to 7,000 fans due to the removal of one of the outfield bleachers... The area has been replaced by the new “Brooklyn Backyard,” a lounge-type atmosphere that allows fans to view the game through the outfield wall... The Cyclones have drawn over 7,000 fans 372 times in franchise history.

SINCE WE LAST MET: Since the Cyclones played their last game, MCU Park has hosted over 100 collegiate, high school and little league games, hosted the New York Empire ultimate frisbee, New York Cosmos soccer, the FDNY vs. NYPD Football game, over 40,000 runners for the Brooklyn Half Marathon and the FXFL’s Brooklyn Bolts.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 100-94...Brooklyn is 52-45 all-time at MCU Park and 48-49 at Staten Island...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team...The Yankees won the season series last year 7-5, including going 6-0 at MCU Park...Brooklyn has not defeated Staten Island at home since August 31, 2014.

SOMETHING OLD: There are six players on the Opening Day roster that played for Brooklyn during the 2015 season: RHP **Nicco Blank**, RHP **Raul Jacobson**, RHP **Erik Manoah**, OF **Hengelbert Rojas**, OF **Enmanuel Zabala**, and C **Brandon Brosher**...Eleven players from the 2015 Brooklyn Cyclones have been released by the organization.

SOMETHING NEW: Eight players from the recent MLB Draft are currently on the Cyclones roster including the 5th round selection SS **Colby Woodmansee** from Arizona State.

OPENING DAY: There are two players who have been in the Opening Day starting lineup for both the Cyclones and New York Mets...**Lucas Duda** was the starting DH for the Cyclones on June 19, 2007 and has been in the Mets Opening Day lineup four times...**Mike Jacobs** was the starting catcher for the first Cyclones game in franchise history on June 19, 2001 and was the Mets Opening Day first baseman on April 5, 2010.

BROOKLYN WELCOMES THE WORLD: MCU Park will host the World Baseball Classic qualifier from September 22-25, featuring Brazil, Great Britain, Israel and Pakistan...Barry Larkin will manage Brazil.

YOU SHALL NOT PASS: Has never walked more than two batters in any appearance as a professional...For his career, has walked just 12 batters in 58.0 innings.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Limited the opposition to a .120 (3-25) average to leadoff an inning last season in four starts with Kingsport.

AMERICAN MADE: Is the first U.S. born hurler to make the Cyclones home opener start since John Gant in 2013...RHP Octavio Acosta (2014) and RHP Gaby Almonte (2015) started the last two Brooklyn home openers.

BULLDOGGIN' IT: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 15th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, Llanes had committed to Fresno State.

IN THE GENES: Gabriel's father - Pedro Llanes - was a 1st round selection (25th overall) in the 1984 MLB January Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Los Angeles-Harbor College...Pitched in the Minor Leagues for four seasons, going 17-33 with 5.35 ERA...Was selected two picks prior to the Mets taking SS Kevin Elster.
