LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones were no-hit for the first time in franchise history, falling in Staten Island by the score of 2-1 in 10 innings...The Cyclones lone run of the game came when **Enmanuel Zabala** scored from third on a wild pitch...LHP **Adrian Almeda** (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing the game winning run to score in the 10th...RHP **Bryce Beeler** tossed 4.0 shutout innings of relief in his first action since Tommy John surgery.

OPENING DAY NOTES: The Cyclones and Yankees played 20 innings on Opening Day...It was the 2nd longest game in Cyclones franchise history behind only the New York-Penn League record 26-inning game between the Cyclones and Oneonta Tigers on July 20, 2006...Cyclones pitchers struck out 22 batters on Opening Day, the record for most punchouts in a game...The previous record was 21 strikeouts, set on June 21, 2002 vs. Aberdeen.

REDECORATING: For the 2016 season, the capacity of MCU Park has been lowered to 7,000 fans due to the removal of one of the outfield bleachers...The area has been replaced by the new "Brooklyn Backyard," a lounge-type atmosphere that allows fans to view the game through the outfield wall...The Cyclones have drawn over 7,000 fans 372 times in franchise history.

O-FER: The Cyclones are 0-2 for the first time since 2013 and for just the fourth time in franchise history...The worst start in franchise history was during the 2006 season when Brooklyn began the year 0-7 before eventually finishing with a 41-33 record and made the playoffs as the Wild Card.

vs. TRI CITY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 41-31...Brooklyn is 21-15 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Cats...From 2002 - 2010, Brooklyn went 30-12 against Tri-City, over the last five season the Valley-Cats have the advantage, 19-11...The Cyclones have gone 6-3 at MCU Park against the Valley Cats over the last three years, and 1-8 on the road over the same period.

SOMETHING OLD: There are six players on the Opening Day roster that played for Brooklyn during the 2015 season: RHP **Nicco Blank**, RHP **Raul Jacobson**, RHP **Erik Manoah**, OF **Hengelbert Rojas**, OF **Enmanuel Zabala**, and C **Brandon Brosher**...Eleven players from the 2015 Brooklyn Cyclones have been released by the organization.

SOMETHING NEW: Eight players from the recent MLB Draft are currently on the Cyclones roster including the 5th round selection SS **Colby Woodmansee** from Arizona State.

THINGS COULD BE BETTER: The Cyclones are batting .074 (7-95) through the first two games, spanning 30 innings...Brooklyn has had more than seven hits on Opening Day in six of the last seven Opening Days.

BROOKLYN WELCOMES THE WORLD: MCU Park will host the World Baseball Classic qualifier from September 22-25, featuring Brazil, Great Britain, Israel and Pakistan...Barry Larkin will manage Brazil.

NEW ARRIVALS: OF **Gene Cone** the Mets 10th round selection from South Carolina has arrived and is expected to be activated in the coming week...RHP **Nabil Crismatt** has also joined the club.
