of the season on Sunday afternoon, defeating the Tri-City ValleyCats by the score of 2-1...RHP Merandy Gonzalez made the start for the Cyclones and tossed 5.1 innings of shutout ball, striking out seven...RHP Alejandro Castro (1-0) got the win and LHP **Taylor Henry** tossed 2.0 scoreless frames for the save...In his professional debut, 3B Jay Jabs had a two-RBI single to provide the offense.

OPENING DAY NOTES: The Cyclones and Yankees played 20 innings on Opening Day, Friday night...It was the 2nd longest game in Cyclones franchise history behind only the New York-Penn League record 26-inning game between the Cyclones and Oneonta Tigers on July 20, 2006... Cyclones pitchers struck out 22 batters on Opening Day, the record for most punchouts in a game... The previous record was 21 strikeouts, set on June 21, 2002 vs. Aberdeen.

REDECORATING: For the 2016 season, the capacity of MCU Park has been lowered to 7,000 fans due to the removal of one of the outfield bleachers... The area has been replaced by the new "Brooklyn Backyard," a lounge-type atmosphere that allows fans to view the game through the outfield wall... The Cyclones have drawn over 7,000 fans 372 times in franchise history.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Three Cyclones collected their first professional hits in yesterday's game...2B Nick Sergakis singled in the sixth inning...OF Jacob Zanon led off the seventh inning with a single...3B Jay Jabs singled to plate a pair of runs later that inning and

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones collected their first win vs. TRI CITY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series 42-31...Brooklyn is 22-15 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Cats...From 2002 - 2010, Brooklyn went 30-12 against Tri-City, over the last six season the ValleyCats have the advantage, 19-12...The Cyclones have gone 7-3 at MCU Park against the Valley Cats over the last four years, and 1-8 on the road over the same period.

> **SOMETHING OLD:** There are six players on the Opening Day roster that played for Brooklyn during the 2015 season: RHP Nicco Blank, RHP Raul Jacobson, RHP Erik Manoah, OF Hengelbert Rojas, OF Enmanuel Zabala, and C Brandon Brosher...Eleven players from the 2015 Brooklyn Cyclones have been released by the organization.

> **SOMETHING NEW:** Ten players from the recent MLB Draft are currently on the Cyclones roster including the 13th round selection C Dan Rizzie from Xavier University, expected to make his debut today.

> BROOKLYN WELCOMES THE WORLD: MCU Park will host the World Baseball Classic qualifier from September 22-25, featuring Brazil, Great Britain, Israel and Pakistan...Barry Larkin will manage Brazil.

> NEW ARRIVALS: OF Gene Cone the Mets 10th round selection from South Carolina has arrived and is expected to be activated this week, pending a physical...In addition, 3B Blake Tiberi, the 3rd round selection from Louisville, is in Brooklyn and will be activated this week, also pending a physical...RHP Nabil Crismatt has also joined the club after spending additional time in extended Spring Training.
