**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones took the rubber match of the three-game series by the score of 8-3 on Tuesday night at MCU Park...RHP **Raul Jacobson** (1-0) got the win after tossing 4.0 shutout innings of relief...A pair of Cyclones who were making their professional debuts led the offensive charge with OF **Gene Cone** going 2-for-4 with three RBI and SS **Colby Woodmansee** adding a 2-for-3 effort with a pair of runs scored and two RBI.

**SOMETHING OLD:** There are six players on the Opening Day roster that played for Brooklyn during the 2015 season: RHP **Nicco Blank**, RHP **Raul Jacobson**, RHP **Erik Manoah**, OF **Hengelbert Rojas**, OF **Enmanuel Zabala**, and C **Brandon Brosher**...Eleven players from the 2015 Brooklyn Cyclones have been released by the organization.

**ROSTER MOVES:** With the Kingsport season set to begin tomorrow, RHP **Adrian Almeida**, INF **Santo Marte**, INF **Franklin Correa**, and INF **Yeffry De Aza** have been transferred to the K-Mets...OF **Vicente Lupo** was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...In addition, yesterday the Mets signed RHP **Justin Dunn** (1st Round) and 3B **Blake Tiberi** (3rd Round) and assigned them to Brooklyn.

**vs. CONNECTICUT:** The Cyclones and Connecticut Tigers have split the all-time series 18-18... Since 2001, the Tigers are the only team to play the Cyclones more than three times and not have a losing record...Brooklyn is 8-11 all-time at Dodd Stadium including 2-5 over the last two seasons...The Cyclones will play the Tigers at MCU Park later this summer on July 1, 2 and 3.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones currently are tied for third in the NYPL with eight stolen bases (Lowell, Auburn - 9)...The Cyclones have been caught on the bases just once.

**SHINE BRIGHT ON THE DIAMOND:** Three members of the 2015 Cyclones participated in the South Atlantic League All-Star Game last night in Lexington, KY as representatives for the Columbia Fireflies...LHP **P.J. Conlon** was the starting pitcher for the South Division and was tagged with the loss after allowing a single run in his lone inning on the mound...RHP **Alex Palsha** tossed 0.1 inning and 2B **Vinny Siena** went 0-for-3 as the North defeated the South 2-1...3B **David Thompson** was named to the team but did not play due to injury...Siena and Palshs were All-Stars with Brooklyn last year.

**PITCHING IN:** Through the first 15 seasons of Brooklyn Cyclones baseball, six different position players have taken the mount for the Cyclones... Through the first five games of the 2016 season, three position players have been called on to pitch.

**BROOKLYN WELCOMES THE WORLD:** MCU Park will host the World Baseball Classic qualifier from September 22-25, featuring Brazil, Great Britain, Israel and Pakistan...Barry Larkin will manage Brazil.

**YOU SHALL NOT PASS:** Has never walked more than two batters in any appearance as a professional...For his career, has walked just 12 batters in 58.0 innings.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** Limited the opposition to a .120 (3-25) average to leadoff an inning last season in four starts with Kingsport.

**BULLDOGGIN' IT:** Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 15th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, Llanes had committed to Fresno State.

**IN THE GENES:** Gabriel's father - Pedro Llanes - was a 1st round selection (25th overall) in the 1984 MLB January Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Los Angeles-Harbor College...Pitched in the Minor Leagues for four seasons, going 17-33 with 5.35 ERA...Was selected two picks prior to the Mets taking SS Kevin Elster.
