**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones fell behind early, and a late-inning rally came up just short as they fell to the Connecticut Tigers by the score of 7-5...RHP **Gabriel Llanes** (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing six runs over 5.0 innings of work...OF **Jacob Zanon** connected on his first professional home run - a solo shot in the ninth inning...Brooklyn brought the go-ahead run to the plate in the top of the ninth, but 2B **Nick Sergakis** grounded out to tend the game.

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The Cyclones are currently tied for second in the NYPL with 9 stolen bases (Lowell-10)...The Cyclones have only been caught once on the bases.

**OUCH:** 2B **Nick Sergakis** has been hit by a pitch four times this season, tied for the league lead with West Virginia's Will Craig...Sergakis was hit a whopping 18 times during his senior season with Ohio State.

**OH-NO-FER:** INF **Dale Burdick** and OF **Arnaldo Berrios** are both 0-for-20 to start the season...The 20 at-bats without a hit are the most among any player in the New York-Penn League...Mahoning Valley's Nathan Winfrey is 0-for-16 and Vermont's Miguel Guzman and Batavia's Javier Lopez are both 0-for-15 to start the year.

**BROOKLYN WELCOMES THE WORLD:** MCU Park will host the World Baseball Classic qualifier from September 22-25, featuring Brazil, Great Britain, Israel and Pakistan...Barry Larkin will manage Brazil...Tickets are just \$15 a game and on-sale now.

**vs. CONNECTICUT:** The Connecticut Tigers lead the all-time series with the Cyclones 19-18...Since 2001, the Tigers are the only team to play the Cyclones more than three times and not have a losing record...Brooklyn is 8-12 all-time at Dodd Stadium including 2-6 over the last three seasons...The Cyclones will play the Tigers at MCU Park later this summer on July 1, 2 and 3.

**START & STOP:** The Cyclones and the Batavia Muckdogs are the only teams in the New York-Penn League to not have a win from a starting pitcher during the 2016 season...The Muckdogs are 0-6, while the Cyclones two wins were both collected by relief pitchers.

**AROUND THE METS:** With full-season clubs at their All-Star breaks, there have been several players moves involving former Cyclones...SS **Amed Rosario** has been transferred to Binghamton (AA) after hitting .309 with 10 doubles, eight triples, three home runs and 40 RBI in 66 games with the St. Lucie Mets...2B **Vinny Siena** was promoted to St. Lucie (A) after hitting .291 with 16 doubles, four triples and 53 runs scored in 66 games with Columbia (A)...LHP **PJ Conlon** was also transferred to St. Lucie (A) after going 8-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 12 starts at Columbia.

**E-FREE:** Last night marked the first game of the 2016 season without an error for the Cyclones...Brooklyn is tied for fourth in the league with nine errors (Vermont 13).

**LEAD POISONING:** The Cyclones are batting just .111 (7-63) to lead off an innings this season.

**OPENING UP:** Made his first start of the season on June 18th at Staten Island...Recieved a no-decision in a game in which the Cyclones were no hit, and eventually lost in extra innings 2-1.

**START ME UP:** Was 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA in nine starts with the K-Mets last season...Struck out 43 and walked just six in 54.1 innings as a starter.

**LONG AND SHORT OF IT:** Allowed 12 homeruns, most in the Appalachian League in 2015...Allowed three home runs in two separate games on July 15th at Princeton and August 24th at Bristol...Seven of the round trippers were hit by lefthanders.

**FIVE AND DRIVE:** Ran into most of his trouble after the fifth inning last season...Through the first 5.0 innings of games, he allowed 16 earned runs in 42.1 for a 3.40 ERA...From the sixth inning on, allowed 20 earned runs in just 23 innings for a 7.83 ERA.

**KEEP EM OFF THE BASES:** Gonzalez allowed the opposition to hit .413 (19-46) with Runners in Scoring Position last year, .333 (31-93) with runners on base and just .224 (37-165) with nobody on base.
