**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones snapped their two-game losing skid with a 2-1 victory over the Connecticut Tigers on Friday night...OF **Jacob Zanon** went 1-for-3 with a two-RBI single that provided all the offense Brooklyn would need...RHP **Merandy Gonzalez** (1-0) tossed 6.0 solid frames allowing one run on four hits while walking two and striking out eight...RHP **Bryce Beeler** pitched 3.0 perfect frames to collect the save...Through 7.0 innings this season, Beeler has not allowed a hit.

**ONE-DERFUL:** After last night's win the Cyclones are now 2-4 in games decided by one run this season...Brooklyn went 14-15 in one-run contests last season and is 210-167 all-time.

**OH-NO-FER:** INF **Dale Burdick** began the season 0-for-21 before getting a hit in Thursday's contest...OF **Arnaldo Berrios** was also 0-for-22 before his bunt single snapped his hitless streak.

**E-FREE:** Last night marked the third consecutive game without an error for the Cyclones...Brooklyn is tied for fourth fewest errors in the league with nine (Staten Island / Lowell - 5).

**LEAD POISONING:** The Cyclones are batting just .150 (12-80) to lead off an inning this season.

**EXTRA-EXTRA:** The Cyclones have 13 extra-base hits this season, 13th in the New York-Penn League...The Batavia Muckdogs are last in the NYPL with just four extra-base hits...The Tri-City ValleyCats lead the league with 27 extra-base hits, including 19 doubles.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Renegades 86-64... Brooklyn has lost only one season series to the Renegades (2010)...Brooklyn is 49-27 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Gades and are 37-37 on the road...The 86 wins against the Renegades are the second most in franchise history, behind the 100 wins Brooklyn has against Staten Island.

**BIG LEAGUE BROOKLYN:** OF **Brandon Nimmo** has been transferred to the Mets and will become the 57th former Cyclones to play in the big leagues and the 38th to play for the Mets.

**PACKING A PUNCH:** 3B **Jay Jabs** has hit safely in each of his six games to start his professional career...The Mets 17th round pick in the recent 2016 MLB Draft is batting .304 (7-23).

**GOOD WOOD:** SS **Colby Woodmansee** has hit safely in three of four games, including a pair of multi-hit games...The 5th round pick is batting .357 (5-14) with four runs scored.

**NEW KID ON THE BLOCK:** Mets 3rd Round Pick 3B **Blake Tiberi** is expected to make his professional this evening...The former Louisville Cardinal ranked second on the team with 27 multi-hit games in 2016 and finished the year with a .331 average in 62 games.


**FRANKLY SPEAKING:** On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.

**LEFT OUT:** Limited opposing lefthanded batters to a .197 (12-61) batting average with only one extra base hit during the 2015 campaign....Lefties went 3-for-6 with one extra base hit in his first start of the season vs. Tri-City on June 20th.

**BETTER LATE THAN NEVER:** The lefthander struck out 35 batters in 25.2 innings during his final five starts of the season in 2015 after beginning the year with 25 strikeouts in 24.2 innings in June and July.

**YOUNG PUP:** Began his professional career with the GCL Mets in 2104 at jue 18 years old , making eight apperances - all in relief...Collected his first professional with on August 23, 2014 vs. the GCL Nationals.

**KEEP EM IN THE YARD:** In 67.0 innings of professional baseball, Huertas has yet to allow a home run...The lefthander has allowed just 14 extra-base hits in his career.
