LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones dropped the series opener to the Hudson Valley Renegades on Saturday night by the score of 6-4... Brooklyn fell behind early when LHP **Joel Huertas** struggled, allowing six runs, earned, on eight hits while walking four and hitting two batters over 4.0 innings of work... The Cyclones rallied late, scoring twice in the ninth and bringing the go-ahead run to the plate, but 3B **Blake Tiberi** grounded out to end the threat and the game.

JOSE IN BK: INF **Jose Reyes** was signed by the Mets to a Minor League contract on Saturday and will report to Brooklyn today...The four-time National League All-Star previously played in Brooklyn on July 18, 2011 vs. Lowell as part of a Major League Rehabilitation assignment and went 1-for-3 with a run scored and a double...The 2011 National League Batting Champion was suspended by Major League Baseball through May 31st for violating its domestic violence policy and was designated for assignment by the Rockies on June 16th.

E-FREE: Last night marked the fourth consecutive game without an error for the Cyclones...Brooklyn ranks second in the NYPL with a .979 fielding percentage and have been charged with nine errors in 427 chances to start the season.

LEAD POISONING: The Cyclones are batting just .159 (14-88) to lead off an inning this season.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Including last night's two runs scored in the ninth, Brooklyn has now scored 17 of their 35 runs in the 7th inning or later.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Renegades 86-65... Brooklyn has lost only one season series to the Renegades (2010)...Brooklyn is 49-28 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Gades and are 37-37 on the road...The 86 wins against the Renegades are the second most in franchise history, behind the 100 wins Brooklyn has against Staten Island.

EXTRA-EXTRA: The Cyclones have 13 extra-base hits this season, 13th in the New York-Penn League... The Batavia Muckdogs are last in the NYPL with just four extra-base hits...The Tri-City ValleyCats lead the league with 27 extra-base hits, including 19 doubles.

BIG LEAGUE BROOKLYN: OF **Brandon Nimmo** has been transferred to the Mets and will become the 57th former Cyclones to play in the big leagues and the 38th to play for the Mets.

PACKING A PUNCH: 3B **Jay Jabs** has hit safely in each of his six games to start his professional career...The Mets 17th round pick in the recent 2016 MLB Draft is batting .304 (7-23) overall.

GOOD WOOD: SS **Colby Woodmansee** has hit safely in four of five games, including three multi-hit games...The 5th round pick is batting .368 (7-19) with four runs scored.

FRANKLY SPEAKING: On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.
