LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones defeated the Renegades 1-0 on Sunday afternoon...RHP **Erik Manoah** tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just one hit and one walk and striking out four...RHP **Raul Jacobson** got the save after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of his own to complete the shutout...SS **Colby Woodmansee** went 4-for-4 with a run scored and a double to pace the Brooklyn bats.

JOSE IN BK: INF **Jose Reyes** was signed by the Mets to a Minor League contract on Saturday and will report to Brooklyn today...The four-time National League All-Star previously played in Brooklyn on July 18, 2011 vs. Lowell as part of a Major League Rehabilitation assignment and went 1-for-3 with a run scored and a double...The 2011 National League Batting Champion was suspended by Major League Baseball through May 31st for violating its domestic violence policy and was designated for assignment by the Rockies on June 16th.

JOSE IN THE FIELD: Last night was Jose's first appearance in a game at third base since August 5, 2000 with the Kingsport Mets at Bristol...Jose has never played the outfield in his professional career.

LEAD POISONING: The Cyclones are batting just .167 (16-96) to lead off an inning this season.

TRANSACTIONS: Following last night's game, OF **Enmanuel Zabala** and RHP **Bryce Beeler** were transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Renegades 87-65... Brooklyn has lost only one season series to the Renegades (2010)...Brooklyn is 50-28 all-time at MCU Park against the 'Gades and are 37-37 on the road...The 87 wins against the Renegades are the second most in franchise history, behind the 100 wins Brooklyn has against Staten Island.

EXTRA-EXTRA: The Cyclones have 15 extra-base hits this season, 13th in the New York-Penn League... The Batavia Muckdogs are last in the NYPL with just seven extra-base hits...The Tri-City ValleyCats lead the league with 32 extra-base hits, including 23 doubles.

PACKING A PUNCH: 3B **Jay Jabs** has hit safely in each of his six games to start his professional career...The Mets 17th round pick in the recent 2016 MLB Draft is batting .304 (7-23) overall.

GOOD WOOD: SS **Colby Woodmansee** has hit safely in five of six games, including three multi-hit contests...The 5th round pick is batting .478 (11-23) with five runs scored.

FRANKLY SPEAKING: On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.

JUNE SWOON: The Cyclones rank 13th in the NYPL with a .187 (73-390) batting average...Mahoning Valley ranks last in the NYPL with a .182 (39-340)...Due to several early season marathons, Brooklyn has 30 more at-bats than any other team.

OPENING UP: Was the Cyclones Opening Day starter on June 17th vs. Staten Island...Did not factor in the decision...The Cyclones lost 3-2 in 20 innings.

START ME UP: Made his first career start with the GCL Mets on July 21, 2015...Between Kingsport (R) and the GCL Mets (R) went 2-1 with a 3.53 ERA in six starts, allowing 14 ER in 35.2 innings.

YOU SHALL NOT PASS: Has never walked more than two batters in any appearance as a professional...For his career, has walked just 15 batters in 68.0 innings.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Limited the opposition to a .120 (3-25) average to leadoff an inning last season in four starts with Kingsport...This year, leadoff batters are hitting .333 (9-27).

BULLDOGGIN' IT: Prior to signing with the Mets after being selected in the 15th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, Llanes had committed to Fresno State.

IN THE GENES: Gabriel's father - Pedro Llanes - was a 1st round selection (25th overall) in the 1984 MLB January Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Los Angeles-Harbor College...Pitched in the Minor Leagues for four seasons, going 17-33 with 5.35 ERA...Was selected two picks prior to the Mets taking SS Kevin Elster.
