LAST NIGHT: RHP **Harol Gonzalez** (1-1) was dominant on the mound for Brooklyn, tossing 6.0 frames and allowing just one run on three hits while walking one and striking out 10 as Brooklyn won their third straight game, 6-2...Offensively it was the bottom of the order that provided the thunder as **Arnaldo Berrios**, **Brandon Brosher**, and **Dale Burdick** were responsible for seven of Brooklyn's 12 hits after combining for just six hits in the first 11 games of year.

10K: RHP **Harol Gonzalez** (1-1) became the 40th pitcher in franchise history to record double digit strikeouts in a game, and the first since LHP **Kevin Canelon** struck out 10 on August 25, 2015 at Hudson Valley...It's the third time in franchise history that a Cyclones hurler has struck out 10 or more against the Spikes, joining Canelon (8/13/15 vs. SC - 11 K) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/13/08 vs. SC - 10 K).

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: Brooklyn scored three runs in the eighth inning last night and have now scored 19 of their 48 runs (40%) in the eighth inning or later.

LEAD POISONING: The Cyclones are batting just .186 (21-113) to lead off an inning this season.

EXTRA-EXTRA: The Cyclones have 19 extra-base hits this season, tied with Connecticut, Auburn and Hudson Valley for 10th in the NYPL...Batavia ranks last in the league with 11 extra-base hits.

NO E IN BROOKLYN: The Cyclones rank fourth in the NYPL with a .972 fielding percentage...The team has just 14 errors in 549 total chances.

vs. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones lead the all-time series against the Spikes 19-11...Brooklyn is 11-4 all-time at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park and has lost just one series played in State College (2014)... Brooklyn went 10-2 in Happy Valley from 2007-2012...The Spikes have gone 5-2 against Brooklyn over the last three years including last night's Brooklyn victory.

POWER OUTAGE: The first Cyclones batter of the 2016 season hit a home run, Brooklyn has now hit just one home run in their next 467 at-bats...The Cyclones have not hit a home run since OF **Jacob Zanon** connected on a solo home run in the top of the 9th on June 22nd at Connecticut, spanning 218 at-bats.

GOOD WOOD: SS **Colby Woodmansee** has hit safely in five of seven games, including four multi-hit contests...The 5th round pick is batting .393 (11-28) with five runs scored.

TRIPLE-A: Former Cyclones Manager **Wally Backman** has been named manager of the PCL All-Star Team in the Triple-A All-Star Game on Wednesday, July 13th in Charlotte...Joining him on the bench will be Mike Shildt, Memphis Redbirds Manager, who was the hitting coach for the Spikes during their Innaugural season in 2006.

FRANKLY SPEAKING: On Sunday, July 3rd the Cyclones will change their name to the Coney Island Franks to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The team will wear special uniforms and caps during the game.
